Vocabulary Word	Definition	Example
Zoo (n.)	an area in which animals, especially wild animals, are kept so that people can go and look at them or study them.	I like to visit the <b>zoo</b> .
Tiger (n.)	a large wild animal of the cat family with yellowish-orange fur with black lines.	<b>Tigers</b> are predators.
Jungle (n.)	a tropical forest in which trees and plants grow very closely together.	Many animals live in the <b>jungle</b> .
Monkey (n.)	an animal that lives in hot countries, has a long tail, and climbs trees.	<b>Monkeys</b> swing on branches.
Penguin (n.)	a black and white bird that cannot fly but uses its small wings to help it swim.	<b>Penguins</b> live in Antarctica.
Snow (n.)	the small, soft, white pieces of ice that sometimes fall from the sky when it is cold, or the white layer on the ground and other surfaces that it forms.	I love to play in the <b>snow</b> .
Camel (n.)	a large animal with a long neck, that lives in the desert and has one or two humps.	I rode a <b>camel</b> .
Desert (n.)	an area, often covered with sand or rocks, where there is very little rain and not many plants.	<b>Deserts</b> are hot.

Sheep (n.)	a farm animal with thick wool that eats grass and is kept for its wool, skin, and meat.	Some carpets are made of <b>sheep</b> wool.
Farm (n.)	an area of land, together with a house and buildings, used for growing crops and/or keeping animals as a business.	Chickens live on the <b>farm</b> .
Cow (n.)	a large female farm animal kept to produce meat and milk.	We get milk from <b>cows</b> .
Horse (n.)	a large animal with four legs that people ride on or use for carrying things or pulling vehicles.	<b>Horse</b> -back riding is fun.
Tired (adj.)	in need of rest or sleep.	I feel <b>tired</b> after running.
Afternoon (adv.)	the period that starts at about twelve o'clock and ends at about six o'clock or when the sun goes down.	I have lunch in the <b>afternoon</b> .

Cinema (n.)	a theatre where people pay to watch films.	I like to watch movies in the <b>cinema</b> .
Movie (n.)	a film shown in a cinema or on television and often telling a story.	Finding Nemo is a nice <b>movie</b> .
Scary (adj.)	frightening.	The dark is not <b>scary</b> .
Buy (v.)	to get something by paying money for it.	I buy snacks from the <b>supermarket</b> .
Popcorn (n.)	seeds of maize that are heated until they break open and become soft and light, usually flavoured with salt, butter, or sugar.	I love caramel <b>popcorn</b> .
Home (n.)	the house, apartment, etc. where you live, especially with your family.	<b>Home</b> is where the heart is.

Restaurant (n.)	a place where meals are prepared and served to customers	Italian <b>restaurants</b> serve the best pizza.
Supermarket (n.)	a large shop which sells most types of food and other goods needed in the home.	I buy chips from the <b>supermarket</b> .
Straight (adj.)	continuing in one direction without bending or curving.	My house is <b>straight</b> ahead.
Stop (v.)	to finish doing something that you were doing.	I couldn't <b>stop</b> laughing.
Turn (v.)	to move in a circle around a fixed point or line.	Do not <b>turn</b> , continue onwards.
Left (adj.)	on or towards the side of your body that is to the west when you are facing north.	My <b>left</b> hand is not strong.
Right (adj.)	opposite of left.	I write with my <b>right</b> hand.
Closed (adj.)	not open.	The door was <b>closed</b> .

Haunted (adj.)	a haunted place is one where ghosts often appear. (Fictional)	<b>Haunted</b> houses are not real.
Ghost (n.)	the spirit of a dead person.	<b>Ghosts</b> are not real.
Curtain (n.)	a piece of material that hangs across a window.	The <b>curtain</b> in my room is blue.
Sofa (n.)	a long, soft seat with a back and usually arms, on which more than one person can sit at the same time.	I like to sleep on the <b>sofa</b> sometimes.
Attic (n.)	the space or room at the top of a building, under the roof, often used for storing things.	We use our <b>attic</b> as storage.

Vocabulary Word	Definition	Example
Key (n.)	a piece of metal that has been cut into a special shape and is used for opening or closing a lock, starting a car engine, etc.	I have a house <b>key</b> .
Treasure chest (n.)	a large, strong box, made of wood with valuable items such as gold, precious stones, or money inside of it.	Pirates look for <b>treasure chests</b> .
Coin (n.)	a small, round piece of metal, usually silver or copper coloured, that is used as money.	<b>Coins</b> are found in the treasure chest.
Diamond (n.)	a transparent, extremely hard precious stone that is used in jewellery, and in industry for cutting hard things.	<b>Diamonds</b> are beautiful.
Silver (n.)	a chemical element that is a valuable shiny, white metal, used for making cutlery, jewellery, coins, and decorative objects	My necklace is made of <b>silver</b> .
Gold (n.)	a chemical element that is a valuable, shiny, yellow metal used to make coins and jewellery.	My ring is <b>gold</b> .
Mask (n.)	a covering for all or part of the face that protects, hides, or decorates the person wearing it.	I wore a <b>mask</b> to the party.

Circus (n.)	a group of travelling performers including acrobats or those who work with trained animals, or a performance in a large tent	I love when the <b>circus</b> is in town.
Fantastic (adj.)	extremely good.	The elephant show is <b>fantastic!</b>
Acrobat (n.)	a person who entertains people by doing difficult and skillful physical things, such as walking along a high wire.	<b>Acrobats</b> are so flexible.
Juggler (n.)	a person who juggles objects in order to entertain people.	The <b>juggler</b> can juggle seven balls at once.
Angry (adj.)	having a strong feeling against someone who has behaved badly.	I don't like to be <b>angry</b> .
Magician (n.)	a person who has magic powers in stories, or who performs tricks for entertainment.	<b>Magicians</b> can perform card tricks.
Trick (n.)	an action that is intended to deceive, either as a way of cheating someone, or as a joke or form of entertainment.	I am learning how to do card <b>tricks</b> .

Fridge (n.)	a piece of kitchen equipment that uses electricity to preserve food at a cold temperature.	I keep my juice in the <b>fridge</b> .
Want (v.)	to wish for a particular thing or plan of action.	I <b>want</b> to take a nap.
Chocolate (n.)	a sweet, usually brown, food made from cacao seeds, that is usually sold in a block and is often used as a flavour for desserts, drinks, etc.	I like milk <b>chocolate</b> more than white.
Enjoy (v.)	to get pleasure from something.	I <b>enjoy</b> baking.
Drop (v.)	to fall or to allow something to fall.	I <b>dropped</b> the ball.
Grass (n.)	a low, green plant that grows naturally over a lot of the earth's surface, having groups of very thin leaves that grow close together in large numbers.	I like to <b>sit</b> on the grass.

Suitcase (n.)	a large, rectangular container with a handle, for carrying clothes and possessions while travelling.	I pack my <b>suitcase</b> before I travel.
Winter (n.)	the season between autumn and spring, when the weather is coldest.	I love playing in the snow in <b>winter</b> .
Summer (n.)	the season of the year between spring and autumn when the weather is warmest.	I like to swim in the <b>summer</b> .
Photo (n.)	a photograph.	I like to take <b>photos</b> of the sunset.
Autumn (n.)	the season of the year between summer and winter, when fruits and crops become ready to eat and are picked, and leaves fall.	<b>Autumn</b> is my favourite season.
Souvenir (n.)	something you buy or keep to help you remember a holiday or special event.	I always buy a <b>souvenir</b> when I visit a new place.
Spring (n.)	the season of the year between winter and summer, leaves and plants start to grow again and flowers appear	Flowers bloom in <b>spring</b> .

Lake (n.)	a large area of water surrounded by land and not connected to the sea except by rivers or streams.	I swim in the <b>lake</b> .
City (n.)	a large town.	I live in the <b>city</b> .

Bring (v.)	to take or carry someone or something to a place or a person, or in the direction of the person speaking.	Can you please <b>bring</b> me a cup of water?
Music player (n.)	an electronic device for playing music.	I listen to music on my <b>music player</b> .
