Young (adj.)	having lived or existed for only a short time and not old.	The young boy played happily in the park.
Tall (adj.)	of more than average height.	The tall man played basketball.
Clever (adj.)	having or showing the ability to learn and understand things quickly and easily.	The clever girl wanted to be a doctor.
Old (adj.)	having lived or existed for many years.	The old man liked to sleep.
Brave (adj.)	showing no fear of dangerous or difficult things.	The brave woman saved the girl.
Spider (n.)	a small creature with eight thin legs that catches insects in a web.	The spider is black.

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Room (n.)	a part of the inside of a building that is separated from other parts by walls, floor, and ceiling.	I could hear people talking in the next room .
Man (n.)	an adult male human being.	The man in the green jacket.
Soldier (n.)	a person who is in an army and wears its uniform, especially someone who fights when there is a war.	That soldier is strong.
Woman (n.)	an adult female human being.	She's a really nice woman .
Child (n.)	a boy or girl from the time of birth until he or she is an adult, or a son or daughter of any age.	A seven-year-old child .

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Watch (n.)	a small clock usually worn on a strap around the wrist	I have a new watch .
Ring (n.)	a circle of any material, or any group of things or people in a circular shape or arrangement.	She wore a gold ring .
Scooter (n.)	a child's vehicle with two or three small wheels joined to the bottom of a narrow board and a long vertical handle attached to the front wheel. It is ridden by standing with one foot on the board and pushing against the ground with the other foot.	Her favourite toy is a little red scooter.
Camera (n.)	a device for taking photographs or making films or television programmes.	Her camera is nice.
Helmet (n.)	a strong, hard hat that covers and protects the head.	I wear my helmet when I ride my bike.

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Family (n.)	a group of people who are related to each other, such as a mother, a father, and their children.	I love my family .
Aunt (n.)	the sister of someone's father or mother.	She is my favourite aunt .
Uncle (n.)	the brother of someone's father or mother.	Uncle Ahmad is kind.
Cousin (n.)	a child of a person's aunt or uncle.	My cousin lives in the same building as me.
Pet (n.)	an animal that is kept in the home as a companion and treated kindly.	I love my pet cat.

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Point (v.)	a particular place.	She points at the horses outside.
Wear (v.)	to have clothing, jewellery, etc. on your body.	We wear the school uniform.
Jacket (n.)	a short coat.	Her jacket is black.
Dress (n.)	a piece of clothing that covers the top half of the body and hangs down over the legs, usually worn by women and girls.	My dress is long.
Door (n.)	a flat object that is used to close the entrance of something such as a room or building, or the entrance itself.	The door is closed.
Shoes (n.)	an outer covering for the human foot.	I love my blue shoes .

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Drink (v.)	(an amount of) liquid that is taken into the body through the mouth.	I drink water every day.
Juice (n.)	the liquid that comes from fruit or vegetables.	Apple juice is my favourite!
Photo (n.)	a photograph.	I love this photo of us.
Sit (v.)	To be in a position in which the lower part of the body is resting on a seat or other type of support, with the upper part of the body vertical.	I like to sit on the comfy couch.
Eat (v.)	to put or take food into the mouth, chew it, and swallow it.	I eat a banana with my breakfast.
Cake (n.)	a sweet food made with a mixture of flour, eggs, fat, and sugar.	I do not like chocolate cake .

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Spaceship (n.)	a vehicle used for travel in space.	The spaceship soared in the sky.
Star (n.)	a very large ball of burning gas in space that is usually seen from the earth as a point of light in the sky at night.	The sun is a star .
Planet (n.)	an extremely large, round mass of rock and metal, such as Earth, or of gas, such as Jupiter, that moves in a circular path around the sun or another star.	We live on planet Earth.
Walk (v.)	to move along by putting one foot in front of the other, allowing each foot to touch the ground before lifting the next.	I walk to school.
Moon (n.)	the round object that moves in the sky around the earth and can be seen at night.	The moon is beautiful.
Toy room (n.)	a room where all the toys are kept and played in.	I like to play in the toy room .

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See (v.)	to be conscious of what is around you by using your eyes.	I can see the stars.
Umbrella (n.)	a device for protection against the rain, consisting of a stick with a folding frame covered in material at one end and usually a handle at the other, or a similar, often larger, device used for protection against the sun.	My umbrella is wet from the rain.
Make (v.)	to produce something.	Do you want me to make some coffee?
Read (v.)	to look at words or symbols and understand what they mean.	I like to read before I sleep.
Book (n.)	a written text that can be published in printed or electronic form.	My book is interesting.
Sleep (v.)	the resting state in which the body is not active and the mind is unconscious.	I sleep at 8:00pm.

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Pyjamas (n.)	soft, loose clothing that is worn in bed and consists of trousers and a type of shirt.	My pyjamas are comfy.
Flower (n.)	the part of a plant that is often brightly coloured and has a pleasant smell.	I water my flowers .
Morning (n.)	the part of the day from the time when the sun rises or you wake up until the middle of the day.	I like to drink milk in the morning .
Get up (v.)	to stand up or to wake up.	I get up early.
Go (v.)	to travel or move to another place	I go to school with my sister.
Live (v.)	(to continue) to be alive or have life or to spend your life in a particular way or place.	I live in Amman.
Breakfast (n.)	a meal eaten in the morning as the first meal of the day.	I have eggs for breakfast .

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Night (n.)	the part of every 24-hour period when it is dark because there is very little light from the sun.	I sleep at night .
Dinner (n.)	the main meal of the day, usually the meal you eat in the evening.	I eat dinner at 6:00pm.
Like (v.)	to enjoy or approve of something or someone.	I like to read.
Chicken (n.)	a type of bird kept on a farm for its eggs or its meat, or the meat of this bird that is cooked and eaten.	Fried chicken is my favourite.
Salad (n.)	a mixture of uncooked vegetables, usually including lettuce, eaten either as a separate dish or with other food.	I like to make fruit salad .
Fish (n.)	an animal that lives in water, is covered with scales, and breathes by taking water in through its mouth, or the flesh of these animals eaten as food.	Fish is delicious.

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Lizard (n.)	a small reptile that has a long body, four short legs, a long tail, and thick skin.	Lizards live in warm environments.
Leaves (n.)	the flat, usually green parts of a plant that are joined at one end to the stem or branch.	Leaves fall in autumn.
Lemon (n.)	an oval fruit that has a thick, yellow skin and sour juice, or the small tree on which this fruit grows.	I like lemons because they are sour.

Letter (n.)	any of the set of symbols used to write a language, representing a sound in the language.	The first letter in my name is N.

Coat (n.)	an outer piece of clothing with sleeves that is worn over other clothes, usually for warmth.	My coat is black.
Skirt (n.)	a piece of clothing that hangs from the waist and covers some or all of the legs, usually worn by women and girls.	I wear skirts in the summer.
