Pet fashion

The manager of the shopping centre said, 'Our plans have changed. The petting zoo will not open. We worked very hard to organise this petting zoo, but we hear you, Pinkton – we will cancel it.'

Don't build on my home

Every year, people build new houses, new shopping centres and other buildings on land that is home for all different kinds of animals. Cities grow and grow and these animals are at risk of losing their homes.

What happens to the animals?

When builders build a shopping centre, for example, the birds, frogs and other animals that live on the land have to find another home. They have to move, but there will already be other animals living in the new place. They can't stay where they are, but there won't be enough food, water or safety in the new place.

We can do something!

We can call or write and complain about new buildings that are destroying the countryside. We must call or write lots of times. The government must listen and stop new buildings taking the homes of animals.
