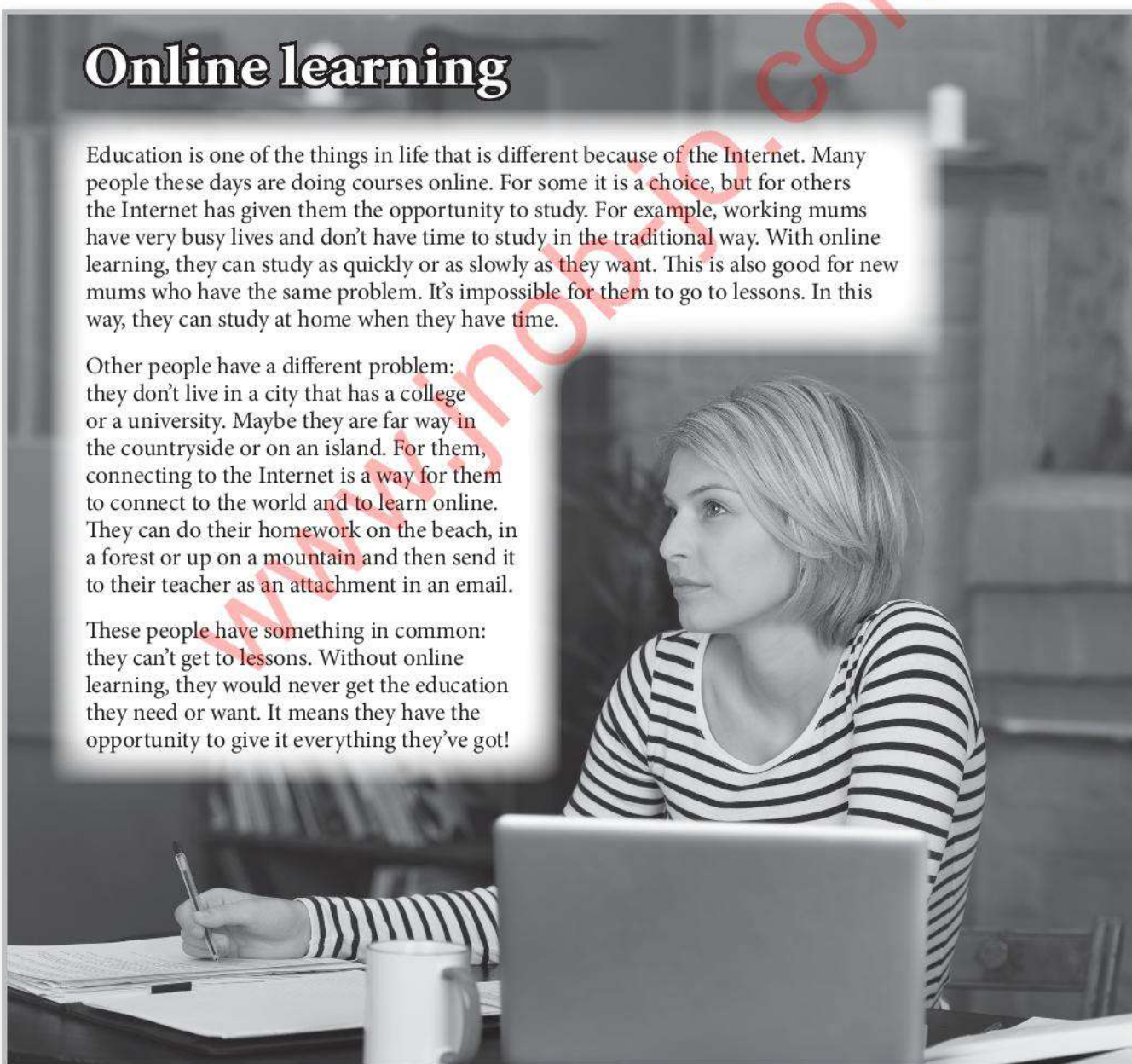

Online learning

Education is one of the things in life that is different because of the Internet. Many people these days are doing courses online. For some it is a choice, but for others the Internet has given them the opportunity to study. For example, working mums have very busy lives and don't have time to study in the traditional way. With online learning, they can study as quickly or as slowly as they want. This is also good for new mums who have the same problem. It's impossible for them to go to lessons. In this way, they can study at home when they have time.

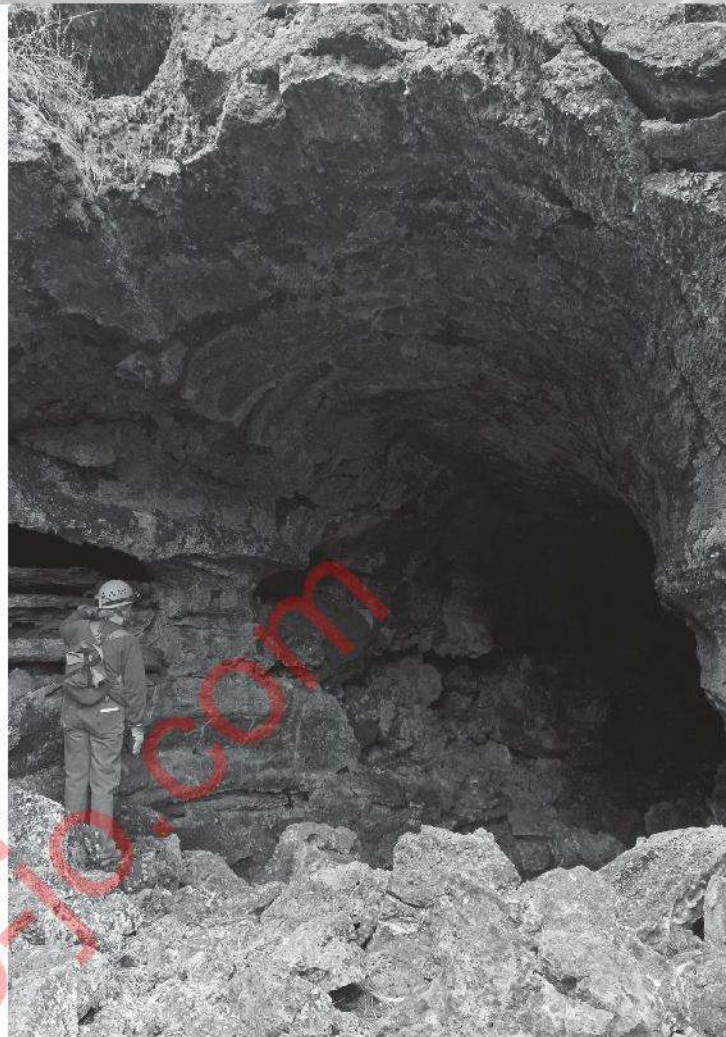
Caving
