### Grammar 1

#### The Passive, present simple:

The passive voice is often used when the doer of the action is unknown.

#### For example:

Active voice: "She writes the report."

Passive voice: "The report is written by her."

## Grammar 2

### The Passive, past simple:

To form the passive voice in the past simple, we use the auxiliary verb "was" or "were" (depending on the subject) followed by the past participle of the main verb. The subject of the sentence becomes the recipient of the action.

### For example:

Active voice: "They repaired the car yesterday."

Passive voice: "The car was repaired by them yesterday."
