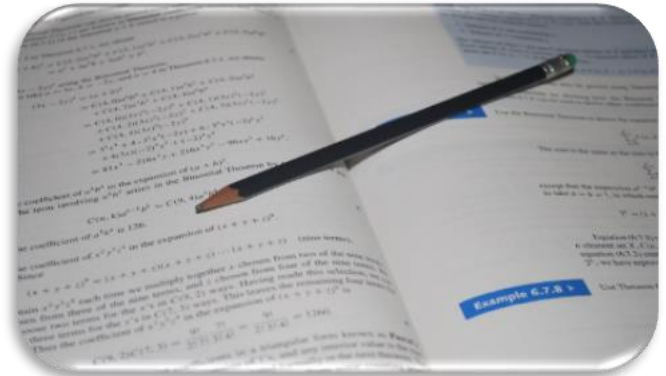

The Solar System

The solar system is a vast and fascinating system made up of the Sun, planets, moons, and other celestial objects like asteroids and comets. At the centre of the solar system is the Sun, a giant star that provides light and heat to all the planets. Without the Sun, life on Earth and in the solar system would not exist.

There are eight planets in the solar system. These planets are divided into two groups: the inner planets and the outer planets. The inner planets are Mercury, Venus, Earth, and Mars. They are rocky and smaller in size. The outer planets are Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune. These planets are much larger and made mostly of gas. Mercury is the closest planet to the Sun, while Neptune is the farthest. Earth, the third planet from the Sun, is the only planet known to support life.

Each planet moves around the Sun in a path called an orbit. The time it takes a planet to complete one orbit around the Sun depends on its distance from the Sun. For example, Mercury takes only 88 days to complete an orbit, while Neptune takes 165 years.

The solar system also includes moons. Moons are natural satellites that orbit planets. Earth has one moon, while other planets have many. Jupiter has more than 70 moons, and Saturn has more than 80. These moons vary in size and composition. Some are rocky, while others are icy.

Asteroids and comets are other objects found in the solar system. Asteroids are made of rock and metal, and most of them are found in the asteroid belt between Mars and Jupiter. Comets, on the other hand, are made of ice and dust. They have tails that glow when they come close to the Sun.

The solar system is a unique and complex system that continues to amaze scientists. Studying it helps us understand our place in the universe and the wonders of space.
