Roast Vegetables in Tomato Béchamel Sauce



1 sachet MAGGI Secrets Béchamel Mix

2 cups red bell peppers, sliced

1 cup eggplant, sliced

1/2 cup carrots, sliced

4 tbsp. olive oil

1/2 tsp. dried thyme

1/2 tsp. dried rosemary

3 tbsp. onions, diced

1 garlic clove, chopped


1 tbsp. tomato paste

Preparation:

- -Prepare the béchamel sauce as per the instructions on the sachet, and then cover and keep aside.
- -Sauté the vegetables with the thyme, rosemary, onion and garlic in oil until half cooked.
- -Add the tomato paste and water, stir continuously on a medium fire for 4 minutes.
- -Add the pasta and then the Béchamel sauce. Season with salt and pepper and stir for 2 minutes on low fire.
 - Sprinkle basil leaves over pasta just before serving

feastsChocolate Truffles




Cuisine: French Course: Dessert (Makes 20-25)

Preparation time: 20-30 minutes Chilling time: 30-45 minutes

Ingredients:

150g dark cooking chocolate, melted 1 can x 170g NESTLÉ Cream 175g cake crumbs 1/2 cup ground almonds chocolate vermicelli or cocoa powder to finish



Preparation:

-Melt the chocolate in a medium bowl over a medium saucepan a quarter full of simmering water, while stirring
