Another reason people do unpaid work is to help others. They volunteer to make their communities better; they spend time with sick children in hospitals; they serve meals to the homeless; or they water the plants in neighbourhood gardens. Volunteers also help people overseas.

VOLUNTARY TOURISM

Recently, it has become common for young people to do voluntary work abroad. These 'voluntourists' teach languages, they work in hospitals or they

help bring clean water to villages. They do it because they want to help others, they want to make a difference. But they also want to travel, to make friends and to challenge themselves in new, exciting and perhaps difficult situations. For instance, many people from around the world apply to volunteer for the Jordan Valley Excavation Project. They hope to use the work to find out about the world and also about themselves.
