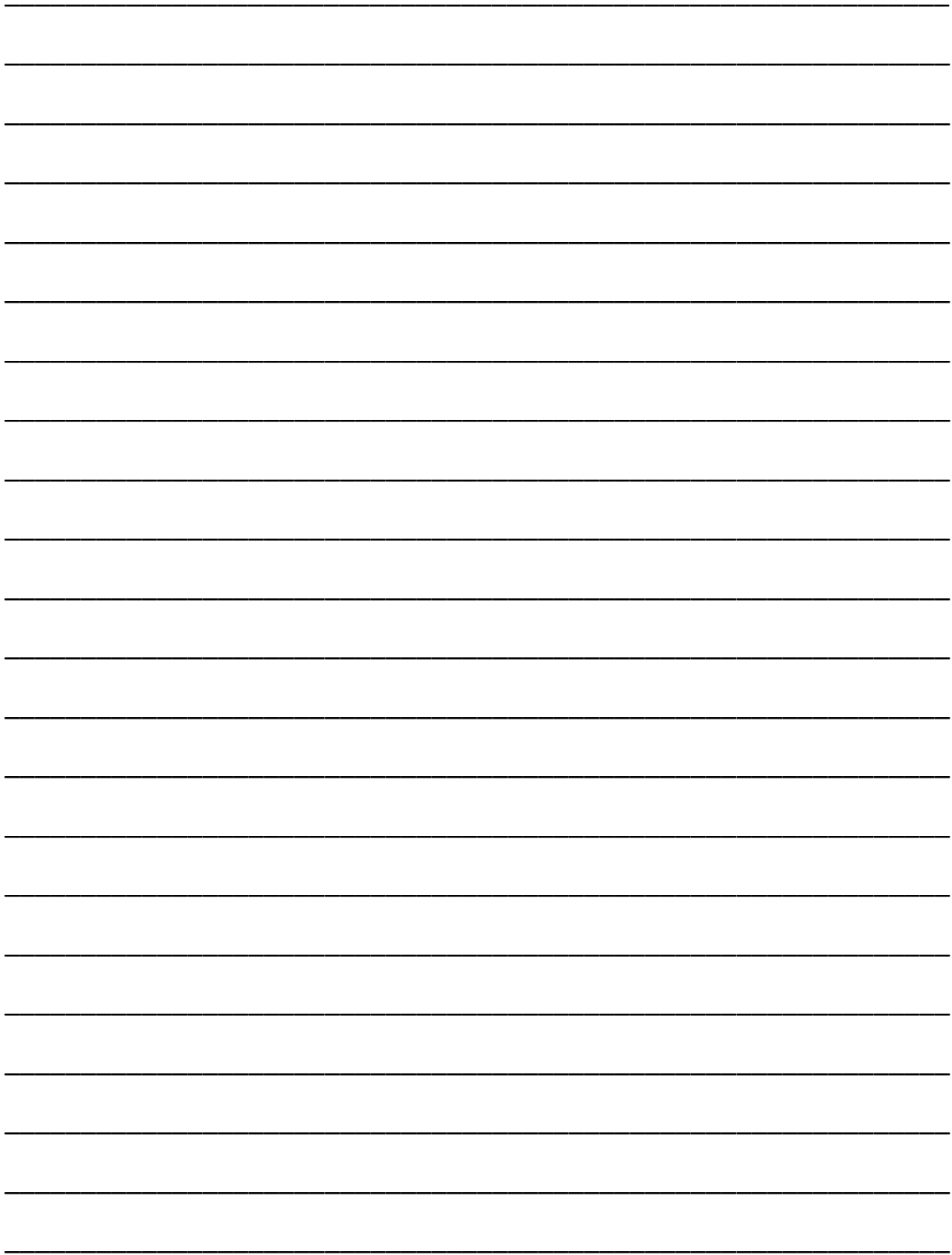
The Mysterious Artifact
