- Pronunciation: /'ɑ:tʃəri/




Athletics

- Definition: Sports that include running and jumping.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: ath-let-ics (3)
- Stress: ath-**let**-ics
- Pronunciation: /æθ'letIks/



Audiobook

- Definition: A book that you listen to.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: au-di-o-book (4)
- Stress: **au**-diobook
- Pronunciation: /'ɔːdiəʊbʊk/



Badminton

- Definition: Similar to tennis; players hit a light ball called a shuttlecock over a high net.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: bad-min-ton (3)
- Stress: **bad**-minton
- Pronunciation: /'bædmɪntən/



Blog

- Definition: A website where you write your thoughts.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: blog (1)
- Stress: **blog**
- Pronunciation: /blog/



Board Game

- Definition: A game played on a board, e.g., chess.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: board game (2)
- Stress: **board** game
- Pronunciation: /bɔːd geɪm/



Book Fair

- Definition: An event where books are sold or shown.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: book fair (2)
- Stress: **book** fair
- Pronunciation: /bʊk feə/



Cartoon

- Definition: A film or TV programme made with drawings
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: car-toon (2)
- Stress: car-**toon**
- Pronunciation: /kɑːˈtuːn/



Cycling

- Definition: The sport or activity of riding a bike.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: cy-cling (2)
- Stress: **cy**-cling
- Pronunciation: /'saɪklɪŋ/




Diary

- Definition: A book you write your personal thoughts in or about what has happened each day.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: di-a-ry (3)
- Stress: di-ary
- Pronunciation: /'daɪəri/



Draw

- Definition: To make pictures with a pen or pencil.
- Word Type: Verb
- Syllables: draw (1)
- Stress: draw
- Pronunciation: /drɔː/



Eco-lodge

- Definition: A special place to stay in the desert.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: e-co-lodge (3)
- Stress: e-co-lodge
- Pronunciation: /'i:kəʊ lɒdʒ/



Energy

- Definition: To do work and not get tired.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: en-er-gy (3)
- Stress: en-ergy
- Pronunciation: /'enədʒi/



Freedom

- Definition: When you can make your own choices and do what you want.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: free-dom (2)
- Stress: free-dom
- Pronunciation: /'friːdəm/



Gardening

- Definition: Growing and taking care of plants.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: gar-den-ing (3)
- Stress: **gar**-dening
- Pronunciation: /'gɑːdənɪŋ/



Gymnastics

- Definition: A sport where people do jumps and other moves to show strength and balance.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: gym-nas-tics (3)
- Stress: gym-**nas**-tics
- Pronunciation: /dʒɪm'næstɪks/



Heat

- Definition: The quality of being hot.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: heat (1)
- Stress: **heat**
- Pronunciation: /hi:t/



Hobby

- Definition: Something you do in your free time for fun.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: hob-by (2)
- Stress: hob-by
- Pronunciation: /'hɒbi/



Hockey

- Definition: A team sport where players use sticks to hit a ball and score goals.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: hock-ey (2)
- Stress: **hock**-ey
- Pronunciation: /'hɒki/



Ice Skating

- Definition: An activity or sport done on ice with special shoes.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: ice (1) ska-ting (2)
- Stress: **ice** skating
- Pronunciation: /aɪs 'skeɪtɪŋ/



Listen

- Definition: To pay attention to someone or something in order to hear them.
- Word Type: Verb
- Syllables: lis-ten (2)
- Stress: **lis**-ten
- Pronunciation: /'lɪsn/



Model

- Definition: A smaller copy of something, e.g., a building or a car.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: mod-el (2)
- Stress: **mod**-el
- Pronunciation: /'mɒdl/



Museum

- Definition: A building where you can see important things from the past.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: mu-se-um (3)
- Stress: mu-**se**-um
- Pronunciation: /mjuːˈziːəm/



Photography

- Definition: The activity of taking photographs.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: pho-tog-ra-phy (4)
- Stress: pho-**tog**-raphy
- Pronunciation: /fə'tɒgrəfi/



Picture

- Definition: An image created to show what something looks like, e.g., a painting or drawing.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: pic-ture (2)
- Stress: **pic**-ture
- Pronunciation: /'pɪktʃə/



Play

- Definition: To take part in a sport or a game.
- Word Type: Verb
- Syllables: play (1)
- Stress: **play**
- Pronunciation: /pleɪ/



Puzzle

- Definition: A game where you fit pieces together.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: puz-zle (2)
- Stress: **puz**-zle
- Pronunciation: /'pʌzl/



Route

- Definition: A path or road to get to one place from another.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: route (1)
- Stress: route
- Pronunciation: /ru:t/



Scooting

- Definition: The activity of riding a scooter.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: scoo-ting (2)
- Stress: **scoo**-ting
- Pronunciation: /'sku:tɪŋ/



Skiing

- Definition: To move on snow using skis.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: ski-ing (2)
- Stress: **ski**-ing
- Pronunciation: /'ski:ɪŋ/



Snowboarding

- Definition: To move on snow using a snowboard.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: snow-board-ing (3)
- Stress: **snow**-boarding
- Pronunciation: /'snəʊbɔːdɪŋ/



Sun Cream

- Definition: A cream used on the skin to protect it from the sun.
- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: sun cream (2)
- Stress: **sun** cream
- Pronunciation: /'sʌn kri:m/




Table Tennis

- Definition: A sport where players hit a small ball over a net.

- Syllables: ta-ble ten-nis (4)
- Stress: **ta**-ble tennis

Volleyball

- Word Type: Noun
- Syllables: vol-ley-ball (3)
- Stress: vol-leyball

- Definition: To look at something for a period of time.
- Word Type: Verb
- Syllables: watch (1)
- Stress: **watch**
- Pronunciation: /wɒtʃ/



Write

- Definition: To make words using a pen or pencil.
- Word Type: Verb
- Syllables: write (1)
- Stress: **write**
- Pronunciation: /raIt/
