Part 1: Relative Pronouns (who – which – where – when)


Read the two sentences. Use the correct relative pronoun to join them. Then write the new sentence below the symbol.

This is the doctor. He works in the hospital.

 → who

This is the doctor **who** works in the hospital.

This is the castle. The king lives there.

 → where

This is the castle **where** the king lives.

I remember the day. We visited Aqaba then.

 → when

I remember the day **when** we visited Aqaba.

That is the tower. You can see it from my window.

 → which

That is the tower **which** you can see from my window.

This is the doctor.

who

He works in the hospital.

This is the doctor **who** works in the hospital.

Relative Pronouns – How and When to Use Them:

Relative Pronoun	Used For	Example
who	People	She's the nurse who helps the patients.
which	Things	This is the book which I like.
where	Places	That's the hospital where my mother works.
when	Time	I remember the time when we had our school trip.

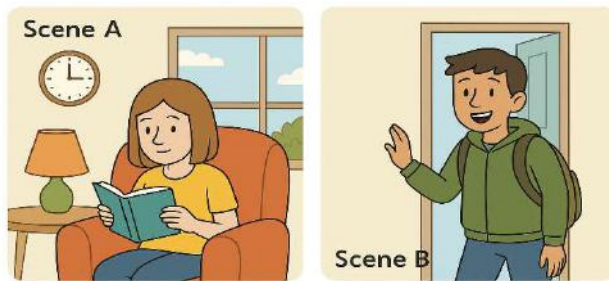
Part 2: Past Continuous (was/were + verb-ing)

We use the Past Continuous to talk about actions that were happening at a specific time in the past.

Examples:

- I **was reading** **when** my friend called.
- They **were playing** football **when** it started to rain.

- Look at the picture:



The girl *was reading* when her brother came home. →

Scene A: A girl was reading a book at 3:00 pm.

Scene B: Her brother came home. (Past Simple)

→ The girl **was reading** **when** her brother came home.

- We can also join two past continuous actions using while:

Example: I **was studying** **while** my brother **was watching** TV.

Summary:

was/were + verb-ing → long action

past simple → short action (interrupts the long one)

when → connects past continuous + past simple

while → connects two past continuous actions
