<b>Relative Pronoun</b>	<b>Used For</b>	Example	
who	People	She's the nurse <b>who</b> helps the patients.	
which	Things	This is the book <b>which</b> I like.	
where	Places	That's the hospital <b>where</b> my mother works.	
when	Time	I remember the time <b>when</b> we had our school trip.

# Part 2: Past Continuous (was/were + verb-ing)

We use the Past Continuous to talk about actions that were happening at a specific time in the past.

### Examples:

- I was reading when my friend called.
- They were playing football when it started to rain.
- Look at the picture:





The girl was reading when her brother came home.

Scene A: A girl was reading a book at 3:00 pm.

Scene B: Her brother came home. (Past Simple)

- → The girl was reading when her brother came home.
  - We can also join two past continuous actions using while:

Example: I was studying while my brother was watching TV.

### **Summary:**

was/were + verb-ing → long action past simple → short action (interrupts the long one) when → connects past continuous + past simple while → connects two past continuous actions
