-It tastes with its feet.

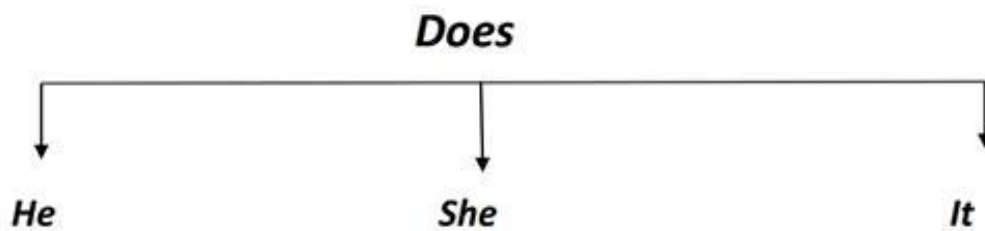
