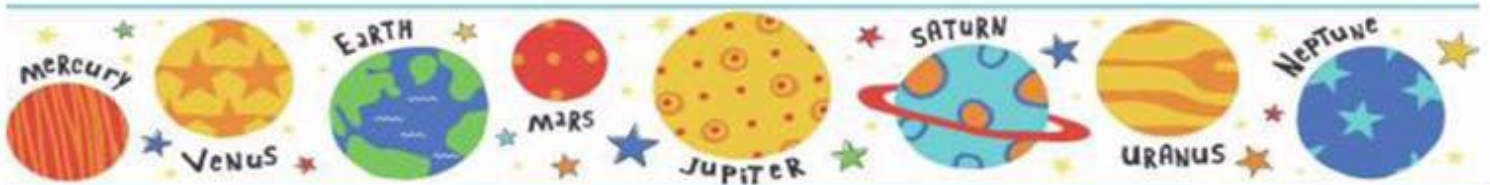

Joud has **more** balls than Elham.

Use **the most** if you are comparing more than two things or people.

Salma has **the most** balls.

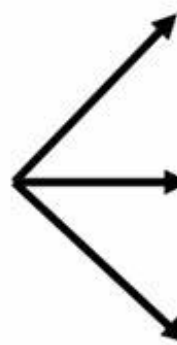

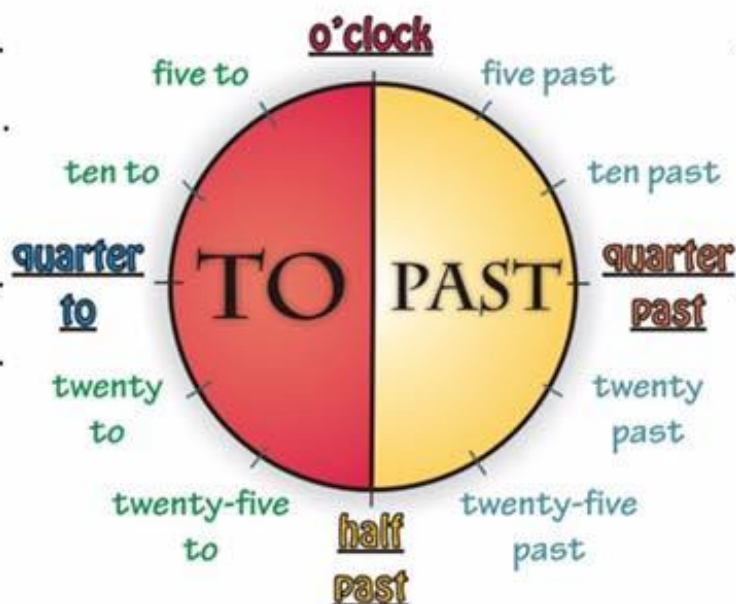

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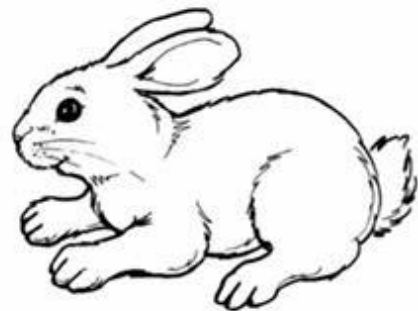
