Rule:

- Use the **base form of the verb** (stop, listen, walk).
- **No subject** (no you).
- Use **Don't + verb** for negative commands.

Examples related to road safety:

1- Stop at the red light.	قف عند الإشارة الحمراء.
2- Look before you cross.	أنظر قبل أن تعبر.
3- Don't play on the road.	لا تلعب في الشارع.
4- Don't run across the street.	لا تجري عبر الطريق
