Recycling means to separate, collect, reproduce or convert used or waste products into new materials. It goes through many steps. It also helps in extending the life of something that has been used once. The process of recycling is not only important for humans but also for our planet itself.

How does recycling happen?

Recycling takes place in three stages. First, materials are collected and sorted into different types such as paper, metal, glass or plastic. Next, sorted materials are reproduced to make new things from the same type. Finally, the new produced materials are sent to the markets to be used again by consumers. When they finish using those materials, the process will start again.

Why Is Recycling Important?

-There are many benefits for using recycling: First, it helps in saving our environment, for example, recycling paper reduces the process of cutting down trees. Second, it saves energy because it takes less energy to reproduce recycled materials than to produce new ones. As a result, the amount of pollution will be reduced. Finally, recycling helps in saving money that means recycled products are less expensive than those made from fresh materials. As the population of the world increases recycling is becoming increasingly more important. More factories are being built and more products are also being produced, therefore there should be clear governmental as well as individual plans to concentrate on reproducing things and reducing the amount of pollution everywhere.
