## Present Simple

شرح القاعدة

Grammar  
rule

المضارع البسيط يستخدم للتعبير عن الحقائق والعادات اليومية

### Affirmative

I walk  
You walk  
He walks  
  
She walks  
It walks  
We walk  
You walk  
They walk

### Negative

I don't walk  
You don't walk  
He doesn't walk  
She doesn't walk  
It doesn't walk  
We don't walk  
You don't walk  
They don't walk

### Third person singular

We add -s to the verb to form the third person singular (**he, she, it**).

I drink - he drinks - I run - he runs

- We add -es to verbs that end in -ss, -sh, -ch, -x, -o.

I watch - he watches

- With verbs ending in **consonant + y**, we change the -y to -ies.

I cry - he cries

But with verbs ending in **vowel + y**, we just add -s as usual. I play - he plays

### We use the Present Simple:

- for **habits** and actions that we do regularly:  
He visits his friends every Sunday.  
She goes to school by bus
- for **general truths**:  
The sun rises in the East.
- for **permanent situations**:  
He lives in Athens.



## Present progressive

Present progressive: ( what is happening now)

I am  
You, We, They are **+ verb-ing**  
He, She, It is  
**Examples**

I am writing.  
You are writing.  
We are writing.  
They are writing.  
He is writing.  
She is writing.  
It is writing.
