We use *and* for adding information,

e.g *She is a nice girl and she is smart too.*

We use *but* for unexpected or different information.

e.g *I want to buy that car but it is very expensive*

We use *because* to give reasons.

e.g *I was absent because I was sick.*

**How to form the simple present tense**

In the simple present, most regular verbs use the root form.

Eg: We go to the park every Thursday.

They watch TV.

Remember the verbs in the third person singular (he, she and it) always take an -s or -es or -ies. For example, "he *plays*, she *sings*, it *works*..."
