








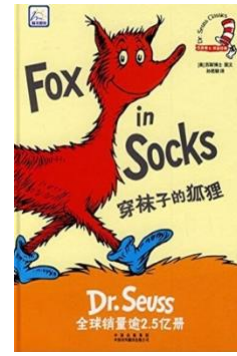
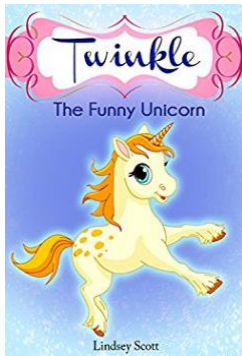

We use An before singular nouns that start with a vowel.

Ex: an igloo

We use A before singular nouns that start with a consonant.

Ex: a book

Vowels are: u a e i o
