1	Actor(n)	A man who acts in a movie. Ex: There are a lot of actors on the theatre.
2	Actress(n)	A woman who acts in a movie. Ex: The actress did well in the film.
3	Boring(adj)	Not interesting or exciting. Ex: This film is boring.
4	Builder(n)	A man who builds buildings. Ex: The builder can build a lot of designs
5	Calm(adj)	Quiet Ex: Be calm
6	Cook(n)	A person who cooks. Ex: My mother is a good cook.
7	Confident(adj)	Having confidence. Ex: You must be confident in your answers.
8	Director(n)	A manager of an organization, company. Ex: My dad is a good director in a big company.
9	Fire fighter(n)	A person who put down the fire. Ex: A fire fighter helps people in bad situations.
10	Friendly(adj)	Behaving in a pleasant, kind way towards a person. Ex: you must be friendly with the others.
11	Gardener(n)	Someone who works in a garden, growing. Ex: There is a gardener in our house.

12	Logo(n)	It is a sign Ex: Each school has a private logo.
13	Pocket(n)	A small bag for carrying things in. Ex: There are a lot of pockets in my shirt.
14	Postman(n)	A person who delivers the letters. Ex: The postman works in the morning to deliver the letters.
15	Presenter(n)	A person who presents things. Ex: There is a program which has a good presenter;
16	Reporter(n)	A person whose job is to discover information about news or events. Ex: Reporter discovers information about news.
17	Sleeve(n)	The part of a piece of clothing that covers some or the entire arm. Ex: You could always turn the sleeves up.
18	Stripe(n)	A strip on the surface of something that is a different color from the surrounding surface.
19	Vet(n)	A doctor who takes care of the animals. Ex: The cat injured her paw, so I took her to the vet
20	Marine biologist(n)	A person who deals with the animals in the sea. Ex: My uncle is a marine biologist.
21	Telephone engineer(n)	An engineer who deals with telephone and fix it.

We use **couldn't+ verb** to talk about something that isn't possible.
