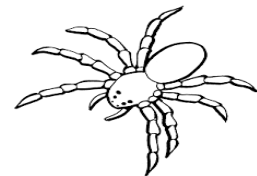
Ants



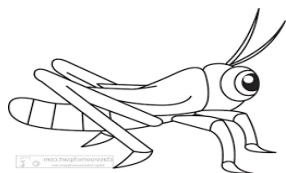
look like	They are insects. They have 6 legs . They have 2 antennae . They feel, smell, taste & communicate using antennae.
live	In big groups . Build homes with many rooms under the ground .
eat	Leaves, seeds, bugs & other things. They leave a smell trail when they go to find food. They carry the food home following the smell.



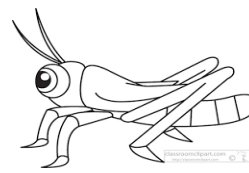
Spiders




look like	They are not insects. They have 8 legs . They don't have antennae or wings . Some have 8 eyes & some have 6 eyes . Most spiders can't see well .
live	Some live under the ground . Some make webs from silk in its body. The silk is very light and strong.
eat	Most of them eat insects . Some big spiders eat mice and small fish.



Crickets



look like	They have 6 legs . They have 2 wings and 2 antennae . They have different colours and sizes. They haven't got ears. They hear through special spots in its legs.
move	They have wings, but most crickets don't fly. They jump. Their back legs are strong.
communicate	They sing by rubbing their wings together. They have different songs.
body parts	

bees	They are helpful insects. They make honey . People like eating honey.
silk worms	They are helpful insects. They make silk . People use silk to make beautiful clothes.
butterfly	It hasn't got a mouth . It tastes food with its feet.
