- We use '**do**' with (I/ you/ they/ we).

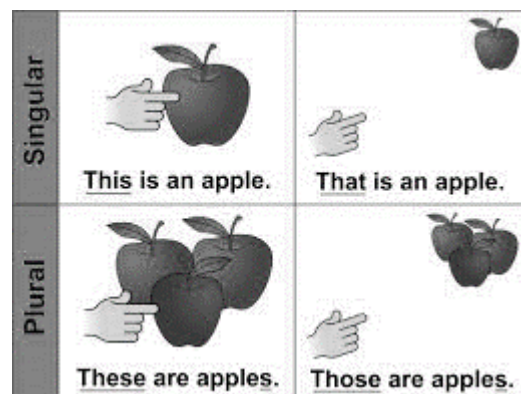
