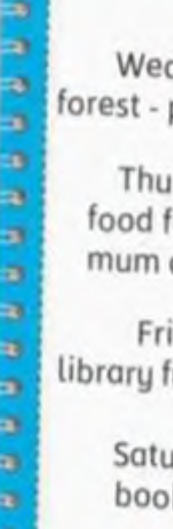

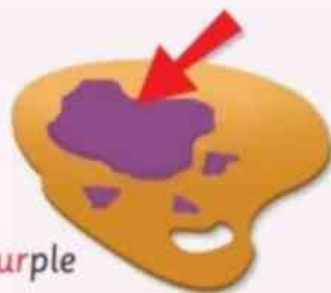

Writing tip



When you write, be careful which tenses you use.

- Use the **Past Simple** to describe when you arrived, what you did, etc. Don't forget to use time expressions, like yesterday morning/afternoon/evening, last Monday/weekend/week, etc.
e.g. *Yesterday we visited Big Ben.*
- Use the **Future be going to** for your future plans. Don't forget to use time expressions, like tomorrow, next Monday/weekend/week, etc.
e.g. *Tomorrow we're going to visit Madame Tussauds.*
- Use **adjectives** to talk about your feelings and impressions.
e.g. *I'm so excited!*
