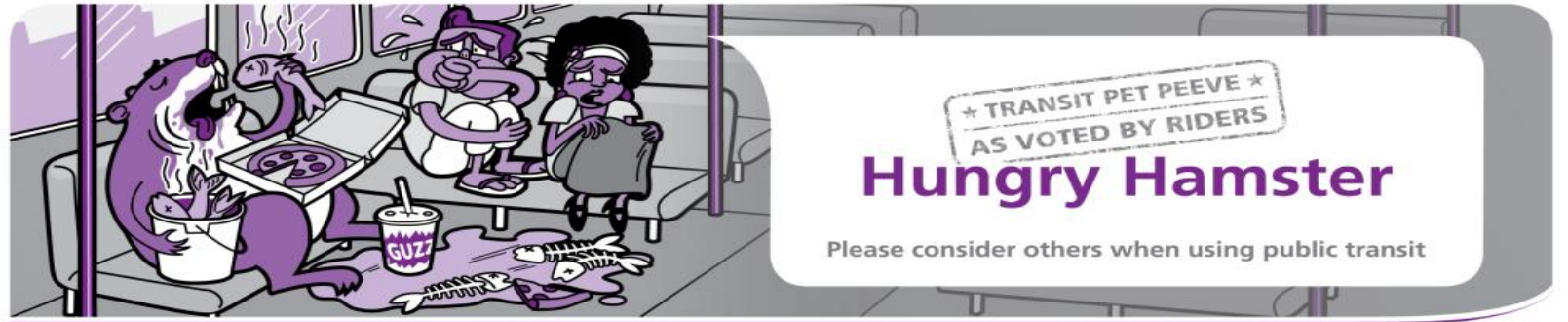

## Reflect & Explain the 2 types of travel

The messenger of Allah (pbuh) said: “Anyone who leaves his house will have two flags at his door, one flag carried by an angel and one flag by a devil. If he is out to do anything to please Allah then the angel will follow him with his flag which he will remain under until he gets home. If he is out to do something that angers Allah then the devil will follow him with his flag and he will be under this flag until returning home.”

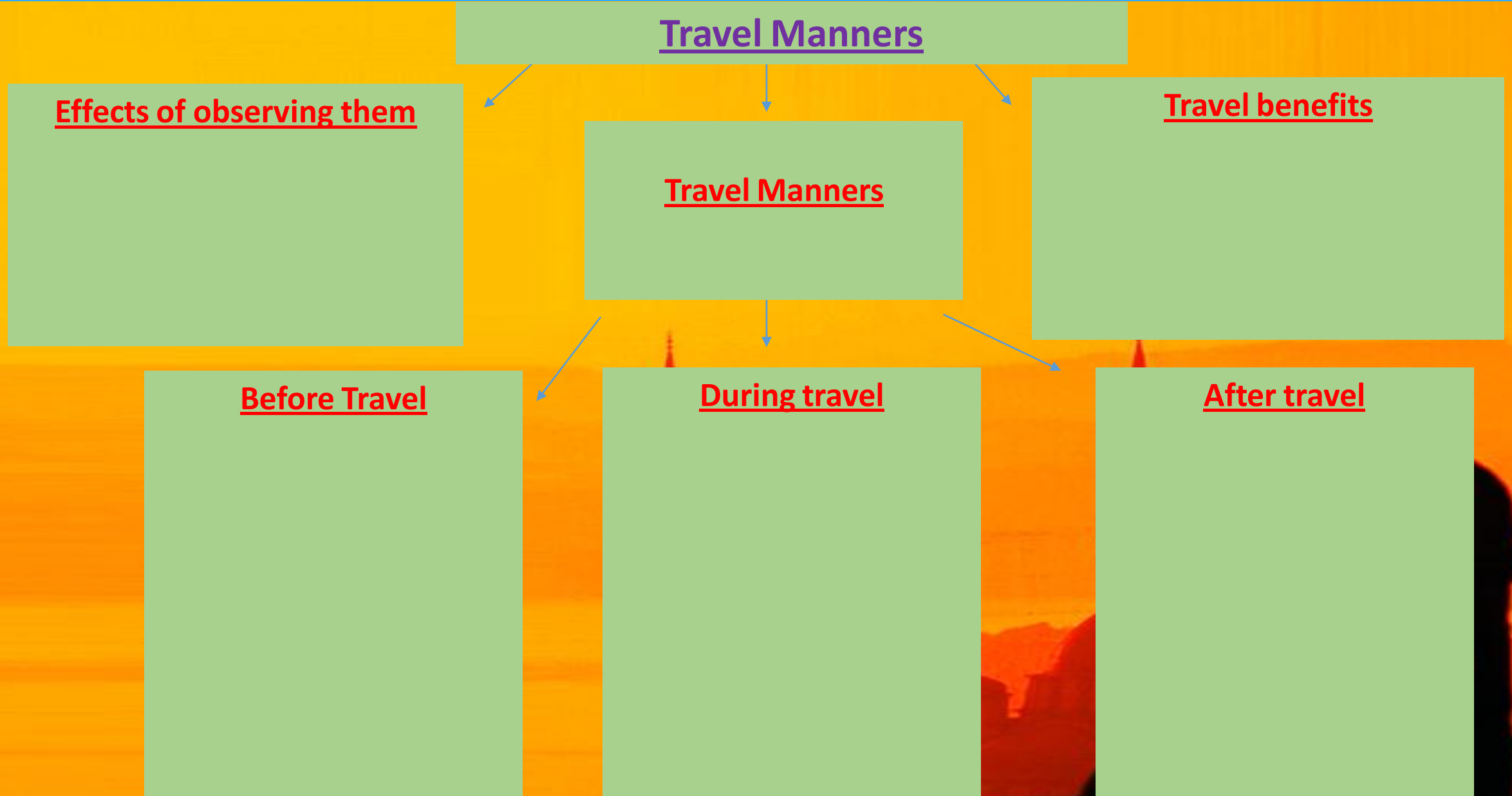
