General Notes

- Planning should be informed by the curriculum standards found in the new English Curriculum Standard Document.
- The number of blocks allotted to each module may vary, depending on the level of difficulty of certain modules.
- The components of the teaching package are full and extensive (**refer to the introduction in the Teacher's Book for more details**). Make the most of the material provided to meet the needs of individual students. It is imperative to plan lessons carefully with these needs in mind.
- The “*Stream Reading*” section comprises 8 reading passages, 3 of which are devoted to the arts streams. These passages do not only cover topics in the corresponding streams, but also provide extra reading practice with a variety of question patterns simulating those found in international exams. Teachers are expected to select one or two of these passages (based on their students’ corresponding streams) for the purpose of enrichment, preparing for international exams and/or developing passion for reading.

Note: The business studies passages can be taught in any stream.

- Not all the exercises in the workbook can be covered in class, so teachers need to use their discretion in deciding which exercises should be tackled in class and which ones should be assigned as homework or quiz.
- It is essential to utilize the material found in the reference sections at the back of the book (Grammar Reference & Speaking Activities) for consolidating, extending and reinforcing what is learned in their respective module.
- The writing sections in the student book and the workbook together fully cover the writing standards.
