General Notes

- For this academic year, teachers are to use the same core resources, Grade 12 F textbooks for all streams.
- The number of days/ blocks allocated for each unit differs according to the nature/ level of difficulty of the unit.
- The core teaching and learning resources are full and extensive. Make the most of the materials in order to meet the particular needs of your students. It is important to plan lessons carefully with these needs in mind.
- The Curriculum Standards to be covered are specified in detail in the standards' tracker placed before each module in the student's book and in the contents section of the workbook. They are included for your convenience.
- Not all exercises in the workbook can be covered in class , so teachers need to be flexible and careful about which exercises should form the focus of classroom study and which ones could be done as homework or quizzes.
- It is essential to exploit the reference materials at the back of the book for reinforcement and learning support throughout the course.
- Some exercises cover the same standards more than once. Depending on the lesson topic and time constraints, teachers can use their discretion and eliminate exercises (where possible) which repeat standards.
- The secondary resources contain a section on 'Further Practice' with additional practice exercises at the back of the book that teachers can draw on for the purpose of differentiation, consolidation or reinforcement to meet specific learning needs.
- The writing sections in the student's book and workbook together fully cover the writing standards.
