Adaptations: how an animal's body help them.	
shark	Thick skin - to keep warm in cold water.
giraffe	Long neck - to eat leaves on trees and see danger coming.
deer	Good hearing and sight - to see and hear danger.
raccoon	Sharp claws - to climb trees for food and safety.
fish	Tails and fins - to swim in water.
beaver	Big teeth - to chew tree trunk and build their house in the lake.
Arctic fox	White fur - to hide in snow and catch small animals to eat.
