27. O you who believe! Enter not houses other than your own, until you have asked permission and greeted those in them, that is better for you, in order that you may remember.

28. And if you find no one in the house, still, enter not until permission has been given. And if you are asked to go back, go back, for it is purer for you, and Allah is All-Knower of what you do.

29. There is no sin on you that you enter (without taking permission) houses uninhabited (i.e. not possessed by anybody), (when) you have any interest in them. And Allah has knowledge of what you reveal and what you conceal.

30. Tell the believing men to lower their gaze and guard their modesty: That is purer for them. Verily, Allah is All-Aware of what they do.

31. And tell the believing women to lower their gaze and guard their modesty, and not to show off their adornment except what (must ordinarily) appear thereof; that they should draw their veils over their bosoms and not display their beauty except to their husband, their fathers, their husband's fathers, their sons, their husbands' sons, their brothers or their brothers' sons , or their sisters' sons , or their women , or the slaves whom their right hands possess , or male servants free of physical needs, or small children who have no sense of the shame of sex ; and that they should not strike their feet in order to draw attention to their hidden ornaments . And you believers! Turn all together towards Allah, that ye may attain success.
