





How Prophet Muhammad (salaaAllahu alayhi wa sallam) received revelation


Aisha Narrated that Al-Haarith bin Hishaam asked Allah's Messenger:

Allah's messenger said: "Sometimes it is revealed to me like the ringing of a bell, this is the hardest for me and then it passes off after i have grasped what has been said. Sometimes the angel comes to me in the form of a man and talks to me and i understand what he says."

Aisha said: "Verily i saw him whilst being divinely inspired on a very cold day and when it was over sweat was dropping from his forehead"

The revelation of Al Quran started in the month of Ramadan during the year 610 AD at that time prophet Muhammad was in a cave called Ghar Hiraa on the Jabal-un-Noor or the mountain of light near Makkah Jibreel AA continued to teach prophet Muhammad passages of al Quran every now and then . the revelation continued throughout the following 23 years of the life of Rasoloullah until he passed away . at that point revelation of Al-Quran was completed.
