Can animals see colours?

In the past, scientists did experiments to discover what colours animals can see. Read and find out the results!

Cats, rabbits and mice can't see green or red. They can only see blue and yellow. Monkeys and some fish are animals which can see many colours, and insects can see even more colours than us! Do you know the colour ultraviolet?

You don't, because you can't see it with your eyes, but only under a special lamp. Birds can see ultraviolet and that's why a bird can see a fish under the water and dive to catch it!

The Caretta-caretta or Loggerhead turtles got the name Loggerhead because they have got a big head

that looks like a log or piece of wood. They have also got strong jaws. Their shells are dark brown and red, and their bodies are dark brown and yellow. Loggerheads weigh from 110 to 140 kilos – that's a lot for a turtle! Loggerheads live in warm oceans all over the world. They don't like cold water.
