



KHOR AL ADAID QATAR'S 'INLAND SEA'

Khor Al Adaid is in the south-east corner of Qatar. Its length is 15 km from north to south and is up to 12 km wide from west to east. Its waters reach the Arabian Gulf through a narrow but deep channel about 10 km long.

The 'Inland Sea' is a place of natural beauty. It is one of just three places in the world where the sea meets sand dunes with a height of about forty metres. It is also the place where you can find sabkhas—flat areas between the sea and the

desert, which collect salt on their surface. There is unique plant and animal life both on land and in the sea. There are Arabian gazelles, Arabian oryx, as well as birds on land. The waters in the area are home to flamingoes and sea creatures, such as turtles as well as some endangered species, like the dugong.

Visitors can take a desert safari tour of the area or spend the day on the beach. It is the perfect place to sit, relax and enjoy some of the country's natural beauty.

Al Zubarah Archaeological Site

ust an hour away from Doha lie the Jruins of the port town of Al Zubarah. It was the most important trading centre of the Arabian Gulf area in the early 18th and 19th centuries.



trade their products from places as far away as China and the UK. The original town had a large port, a fort, a palace, beautiful mosques, and houses with large courtyards, which were home to about ten thousand people. Many of the residents were fishermen and pearl divers.

All of the people left the town in 1811, and the desert sands covered it almost completely. In 2013, UNESCO named the area a World Heritage Site – the first ever in Qatar.

Today, archaeologists and researchers are carefully trying to return the town to its past glory as it is a symbol of Qatar's past and its cultural heritage.

Qatar's friendly giant

The dugong is a large sea mammal which lives in the warm coastal waters of the western Pacific Ocean, the Arabian Gulf and the Red Sea. It can weigh over 400 kilos and can grow to a length of about 4 metres. The dugong eats the seagrass which grows on the seabed of these coastal areas.



However, these amazing animals are in danger of losing their habitat and food because of pollution. If people don't stop polluting the seas, this sea creature will disappear. Dugongs can stay underwater for about six minutes; this means that they must often lift their heads above the surface of the water to breathe. So, ships and fishing equipment, like nets, are dangerous for dugongs because as the animals swim up to the surface, they may get caught in this fishing equipment. As a result, they can get hurt or die.

Today, the second largest number of dugongs exists in the waters round Qatar. Organisations and scientists from Qatar University are working together to protect its habitat and to inform people about the importance of this animal.
