


The Ras Abu Aboud Stadium will be different from the other seven stadiums in Qatar because they are building it with shipping containers! It will be the first one made this way in the world! This is very good for the environment because it needs fewer building materials, so there is less waste. It also saves energy, reduces air pollution and is cheaper and quicker to build.



Recycling

Recycling has a long history. In the past, people couldn't make things quickly and cheaply, so they used to reuse and recycle things. You do the same when you use an empty cereal box for an art project. In Japan, people recycled paper in the 11th century. They used recycled paper to paint on and to write on. In 1690, people started recycling in America. They used recycled paper to make books and newspapers. In the 1970s, people started thinking more about the environment. In the US, recycling became very popular and people celebrated Earth Day for the first time on 22 April 1970.

Today it is easier to make things, so people often throw old things in the bin to buy something new. This is why nowadays there is more rubbish than there was in the past.

Luckily, today we can recycle almost anything: glass, plastic, metal, paper, batteries, electronic devices, even food. It usually takes less energy to recycle something than to make something new. For example, recycling a can saves 95% of the energy we need to make a new can.

Remember! Reusing and recycling are great ways to help protect the environment... but if we don't buy lots of things, there will be even less rubbish.

There is a long tradition of diving in Qatar. For thousands of years, brave swimmers dived for pearls and then sold them for high prices all over the world. Special boats, called dhows, went out to sea between June and September, with about twenty men on them.

Divers threw a rope over the side of the boat with a rock tied to the end before jumping into the sea. After collecting as many oysters as they could, they held onto the rope and somebody in the boat pulled them out of the water. Not all oysters contain pearls, so they had to catch thousands just to find a few. Pearl diving was very dangerous because there weren't any oxygen tanks in the past and also because of the sharks which sometimes attacked the divers.

Nowadays, few people dive for pearls anymore but scuba diving has become very popular both with Qataris and with people from abroad. It is an exciting watersport which gives people the chance to explore the amazing world under the sea and take photos of colourful fish and other beautiful sea creatures. Of course, before going scuba diving for the first time, it is necessary to learn how to swim under water using oxygen tanks. There are plenty of amazing places in Qatar to enjoy this wonderful activity every month of the year. Some of these are at Al Khor, Zeytuna, Khor Al Udaid and Mesaieed.


