



THE IMPORTANCE OF COMMUNICATION SKILLS

A recent government report has shown that a large number of young children in the UK are suffering from communication problems. Education professionals suggest that a lot more emphasis has to be placed on the development of communication skills in primary schools. In fact, communication is the key life skill that children need in order to learn all other skills.

To begin with, the report showed that about 50,000 children starting school in the UK have significant speech difficulties and approximately 6,000 have serious communication difficulties. In addition, in some regions of England, it was found that up to 50% of school children have communication problems. Although it is not clear what causes these problems, researchers believe that lifestyle plays an important role and that factors such as exposure to video games and television at an early age are partly responsible.

Consequently, government researchers recommend that parents should spend more time with their children in order to improve their communication skills. For example, families should eat meals together or do fun activities that require conversation. Furthermore, teachers and other education professionals should be better trained to help children with their communication needs.

Abdulaziz Al-Mahmoud

The best-selling author Abdulaziz Al-Mahmoud was born in Doha, Qatar. He is known internationally for his historical novels that bring the rich history of the Arabian Gulf region to life.

The talented Al-Mahmoud did not start out as an author. He graduated in 1989 and then served as an engineer in the Qatar Emiri Air Force. Since 1997, Al-Mahmoud has been a journalist. He has written for and managed several important newspapers in Qatar, both in Arabic and English. This gave him experience in writing as well as in research.

In 1996, in a bookshop in the UK, he came across a book that brought him into contact with a fascinating period in the history of the Gulf region: the 1800s. He was surprised at how little people knew about this period, when the Gulf was just as essential as it is now to international sea-trade. The great powers of the day, like the British and the Ottoman Empires, all wanted to control the area. It was during this time that local pirates played a big role.

Al-Mahmoud began to research these amazing people who lived long ago. For years he read everything he could find on the pirates of the Gulf. Were they criminals or heroes? The result of this research, in August 2011, was a historical novel called *The Corsair*. The central character in this action-packed book is the legendary Rahmah ibn Jabir al-Jalahimah. Through the adventures of real people, rich and poor, the book tells the story of the region in a way no history book can. *The Corsair* was a big success and was translated into English two years later. Though it was only his first novel, it put Al-Mahmoud on the map of world literature.

In November 2014, Al-Mahmoud came out with a second book, *The Holy Sail*, which was also translated into English one year later. This book goes 500 years further back in history, to the wars of the Portuguese in the Arabian Peninsula.

Al-Mahmoud believes it is important to develop new writers, and he has taught seminars on how to research and write a novel. His books continue to inspire a love of history.
