## General Notes

- When planning, teachers are to refer to the standards found in the teacher’s book.
- The number of blocks allocated for each module differs according to the nature / level of difficulty of the lesson.
- The teaching package components are full and extensive (refer to the introduction in the Teacher’s Book for more details). Teachers are requested to make use of the online resources; interactive CD, tests (for assignment & enrichment purposes), etc.
- Not all the exercises in the workbook can be covered in class, so teachers need to be flexible and careful about which exercises should form the focus of classroom study and which ones could be done as homework or quizzes.
- The writing section in the WB should be covered in class.
- Reading and writing lessons to be covered in **two** blocks.
- The skipped lessons (**referred to in the table above**) can be exploited as enrichment material but are not to be assessed. The “Culture Pages”, “pomes” and the “Tasks” can be dealt with likewise.
- It’s preferable to have a unit test after each module.
- The speaking and the grammar reference sections are essential parts in the textbook. Thus, teachers are requested to exploit them appropriately.
