Hi Fahad ,

How are you? I hope you are fine. I'm writing this letter to tell you about sports in Qatar. **Traditional** sports in Qatar include Arabian horse racing, camel racing, and falconry, which were all rooted in the country's nomadic past. Modern western sports such as basketball, golf, swimming, football , table tennis, and volleyball are widely played. However, football has become the most popular sport.

The 15th Asian Games, Asia's Olympic-style sporting event, was held in Doha, Qatar in the Khalifa International Stadium in December 2006. Doha was the first city in this region and only the second in West Asia (following Tehran in 1974) to host the Games. It was the first time that all 45 member nations of the Olympic Council of Asia took part in this sporting event. Football is clearly the most popular sport in Qatar, and has been given a greater encouragement with the country because Qatar has been awarded the 2022 FIFA World Cup.
