**Fiction books** tell a story that is not real.

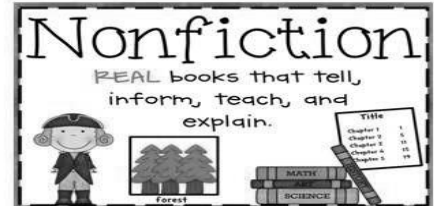
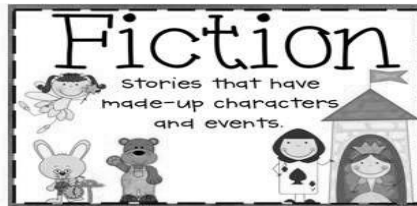

**Characters** are the people or animals in a story.

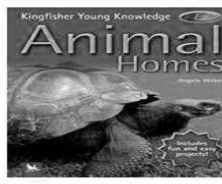
