In the 1950s, television was still a new and wonderful form of entertainment for American families. Movie makers worried about people staying home instead of going out to theatres. Advertisements about movies tried to bring people back into the cinemas. Movie also worked on developing new ideas to bring people back. One of these was 3D movies. 3D movies are filmed with two cameras, spaced apart like two eyes are spaced apart. Movie fans in the past had to wear special glasses to see the two images as one. 3D film makers knew that 3D itself was new and interesting and it wasn't enough to win viewers. The content of these films would have to be dynamic. The first 3D movie was *Bwana Devil* and it was followed by *House of Wax*. It is an adventure story about African lions attacking young men. At the top, approximately five thousand theatres in the US were showing 3D movies.

Unfortunately, there were some problems. Displaying these films required some technical skills. If the 3D films weren't displayed exactly right, they would not be clear even when viewed through the glasses. Also, some people suffered headaches and pain in the eyes from using the glasses. So, 3D movies began to die away.

The technique was never forgotten though, and 3D films can be viewed with glasses at IMAX theatres. *Avatar* and *Ice Age*, very popular 3D films shown in regular theatres, won many major awards in 2010. Last, don't throw away your glasses. 3D is here to stay!
