The Amazing Giraffe

1- Giraffes are the tallest animals on earth. Male giraffes can grow to a height of about 17 feet. If you lived in a block of flat an adult giraffe could look into your bedroom window on the second floor. Giraffes only live on the continent of Africa. The only giraffes in the United States are found in zoos or animal parks. Visitors love to see the giraffes because they are so tall.

2- Besides standing on long legs, giraffes have the longest neck of any animal so they can **grab** food easily . The neck of a giraffe can be eight feet long .

3- With their great height, giraffes easily eat leaves from the tops of acacia trees. Giraffes get enough food because no other animals can reach the same food that giraffes like. Giraffes spend most of their time eating.

The ostrich is the largest and heaviest bird that is alive today. Although it cannot fly, the ostrich is also the fastest-running bird. It can run up to about 70 kph.

These social birds live in travelling groups of 5 to 50 birds. Ostriches are farmed for their meat, leather, and feathers.

The ostrich can grow up to 9 feet tall and weighs up to 156 kg. The ostrich also has the biggest eyeballs of any bird alive today. It has a long neck that allows it to see hunters from far away. The ostrich has tiny, almost useless wings. The legs are long and powerful; there are two toes on each foot. The fluffy feathers are black, white, and brown, which helps hide this large bird in its habitat.

Scientists know many things about the Sun. They know how old it is. The Sun is about 5 billion years old and they say that it will probably shine for another 2 billion years. The Sun is one of the 100 million stars in our galaxy. It is the closest star to the Earth. Besides the Sun, the Solar System is made up of the planets, moon and other objects. The Earth and other planets revolve around the Sun.

Scientists have learned many things about the Sun. They study the Sun using special tools or instruments such as telescopes. It's a big powerful ball of gas. The Sun may seem small, but that is because it is so far away. It is about 150 million kilometers away from the Earth. The light from the sun takes eight minutes to get to Earth. The Sun is so large that the diameter of the Sun is 109 times the Earth's diameter.it also weighs as much as 333,000 Earths.

The Sun is very important. Without it, there would be only darkness and our planet would be very cold and be without liquid water. Our planet would also be without people, animals, and plants because these things need sunlight and water to live. The Sun also gives out dangerous rays which cause sunburn and may cause cancer. That is why you need to be careful of the Sun and wear sunscreen and clothing to protect yourself from its rays.


