



Justice: Achieving the principle of justice among societies leads to the promotion of the principle


of culture of peace among them.

Tolerance: Pursuing tolerance among human beings, regardless of their differences, leads to the dissemination of culture of peace.

Acceptance of other and renunciation of violence: Adopting the renunciation of violence and its aspects, and the dissemination of relations based on peace, respect for life, and the adoption of methods of peaceful dialogue.



Second: Means of Spreading Culture of Peace:





On November 20, 1997 AD, the General Assembly of the United Nations issued its resolution declaring the year 2000 AD the "International Year for the Culture of Peace". On November 10, 1998, it adopted its resolution declaring the first decade of the new century (2001 AD-2010 AD) to be the "International Decade for a Culture of Peace and Non-Violence for the Children of the World". On October 6, 1999, the General Assembly issued the Declaration on the Culture of Peace, which was considered a general guide for governments, international organizations and the international community to support and promote a culture of peace.

Third: Fields of application of culture of peace:

1. Political Field:

It means full respect for the sovereignty and independence of states, and non-interference in their internal affairs, while guaranteeing human rights and freedoms, settling conflicts by peaceful means, and spreading the concept of a culture of dialogue; locally and internationally.

(Maintaining the regional and international peace and security is a priority in the State of Qatar's foreign policy, whose principles and objectives are based on the United Nations' charter and the rules of international legality which calls for constructive cooperation among States, mutual respect and non-interference in the internal affairs, good neighborliness, as well as promoting peaceful coexistence and pursuing peaceful means to settle disputes).


Hamad Bin Khalifa Civilization Center



The civilizations dialogue is a human necessity that Allah the Exalted and Glorious commanded us in all the divine religions to establish the principles of love, goodness and peace among people on the earth as Allah commanded us to do in his holy verses: I "O humanity! Indeed, We created you from a male and a female, and made you into peoples and tribes so that you may get to know one another. Surely the most noble of you in the sight of Allah is the most righteous among you. Allah is truly All-Knowing, All-Aware." [Al-Hujurat: verse 13]

The subject of the civilizations dialogue is recently appeared by the French thinker (Roger Garaudy) as one of the fields that should be cared about to find a common ground for understanding at the level of the peoples of the earth and is called this (the civilizations dialogue).

The peoples of the world with different cultures, races or religions share their opinions and problems and determine the solutions to these problems so that they have the ability to become acquainted, communicate, eliminate the conflicts and positively interact in a civilized manner among the peoples.





The State of Qatar plays significant roles in counter terrorism by its significant efforts in support peace and stability internationally and regionally. The state of Qatar has affirmed in many events its strong condemnation and rejection for all forms of terrorism. Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani emir of Qatar, said in his speech in Munich Security Conference in February 2018:



Cybercrime Law in the State of Qatar:

The state is keen on the security and safety of society and protects it from cybercrimes, which has become a tangible reality that jeopardizes the interests of states, their security, their economy, and their members. Therefore, it issued the Cybercrime Law No. 14 of 2014.

The law included all aspects related to combating cybercrime, and specified many articles that punish acts and deeds that affect personal life, society and the right of the state. Article No. (6) stipulates that a penalty of imprisonment not exceeding three years and a fine of not more than 500,000 riyals, or one of these two penalties, shall be imposed on anyone who establishes or manages a website through the information network to publish incorrect news, with the intent of endangering the safety of the State, its public order, or its internal or external security.


Shura

What Shura means for you?

Shura is one of the governance principles that used since ancient times, Arab people before Islam used Shura as a political and social alternative to governance. for example, Qurayshy people were gathering in a seminar council as evidence for applying Shura principle in Arabs life.



In the Arabian Peninsula, many systems of government emerged in the centuries preceding Islam. For example, in Yemen, emerged the Kingdom of Sheba, which was governed by a monarchy system applied a kind of Shura principles. The Almighty said: "She said, "O chiefs! Advise me in this matter of mine, for I would never make any decision without you." [An-Naml: Verse 32)

After advent of Islam, the principle of shura was enhanced, the Almighty said: "and consult with them in conducting matters." [Ali 'Imran: Verse 159]. The policy that used by the Prophet Mohammad peace be upon him was based on applying Shura principle, so he was not to take a decision in life matters without take advisory (Shura), he used Shura principle as a lifestyle.


Prophet Mohammad (Allah's blessing and peace be upon him) applied shura principle in situations and events, including:

- when the prophet peace upon him told that Qurayshy people arrived to the outskirts of the Medina to fight him, he takes advice of from his companions.

his opinion (Allah's blessing and peace be upon him) was to not go out from the city, but most Muslims were willing to go to Mount Uhud to fight the polytheists there, then prophet Muhammad peace upon him agreed their opinion and decided to go to Uhud.








>> 1.The principle of separation of authorities

The principle of separation of authorities is the most important principle of democracy at all, and the main pillar for success for any country seeks to implement the democratic system in ruling, and it means that each authority exercises its authority or function independently from the other, but cooperates with each other.



If the principle of separation of authorities applied, the political system of the state become closer to the democratic system.



>> The inpatance of separation of authorities :-

- 1. Ensure independency and fairness by separate Shura Council from the government on the one hand and separate the judicial authority from the rulers on the other hand.

The Universal Declaration of Human Rights is a historic document very important for human rights history, drafted by representatives have different backgrounds legally and culturally from all over the world. the general assembly approved The Universal Declaration of Human Rights in Paris on 10th of December 1948 AD. defining (for the first time) the basic human rights that should be protected globally, these rights translated into 500 languages worldwide.

Environmental and Developmental Rights:
As a result of the increasing conflicts and disputes, as well as growing of environmental imbalance, the spread of famine, diseases and the technological revolution, other rights have emerged, called the third generation of human rights. Examples of these right are: the right to peace- the right to a clean and free of destrucation environment- and the right to share information.

>> Social and Cultural Rights:

called the second generation of human rights, it is a basic rights of the human rights and an integral part of it, mostly considered as collective rights not individual rights, examples of these rights:

- Right to comprehensive health care.
- Right to social protection and a decent standard of living.
- Right to benefit from protection of moral and material interests that resulting from any scientific, literary or technical work produced by a person.

>> Economic Rights:

The right to exercise economic activity and satisfy needs considered among the rights that can not be neglected or abandoned, because it related to life and fate of people, examples of these rights:

- The right to property.
- The right to work in stratifying equitable conditions.
- The right to get average income provide a decent standard of living for people.



Second: The Components of Political Security:

How can a country achieve its political security?



>> 1. Sovereignty:

It means the state's full control over its land, sea and air borders, and all individuals and organizations affiliated with it, and the preservation of its independence from any external control.

It also means a set of powers or rights that allow the state - within the limits of the law - to exercise all legislative, executive and judicial powers without foreign interference.



It is clear from the above that:

The state cannot give up its sovereignty because that means the end of the state. Also, sovereignty cannot be divided. If the state is fragmented and disintegrated, this means its end.

>> 2. Permanent Constitution:

The constitution is the basic document that includes the fundamental principles guiding the state's policy in various fields, the organization of its powers, the system of governance, and the determination of public rights and duties. It is one of the most important components of the state's political security.





Figure 1 Car roads in Qatar






Figure 2 Qatar's Ports Map




