



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Objective: Using will not, might not



LANGUAGE TIP

Use *will not* or *might not* to make a negative prediction about the future.

There might not be enough food.

Modal Verbs: Probability **might not**

Expressing 50% probability that something is false



It **might not** be a good day for a picnic. It's cloudy and a bit chilly.



S+will/shall + V(bare form)

I will go to Thailand.

S + will not/won't + V(Base form)

I will not go to Thailand.

Will + S + V(Base form) +...?

Will you go to Thailand?



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
