2. The evil whisperer is **Shaytan**. Shaytan is the biggest enemy of humans. He wants us all to go the hell-fire along with him.
3. Shaytan has many helpers and partners from among the **jinn and humans.**
4. **Jinn** are another creation of Allah who are created from **fire**. They are invisible, so we cannot see them.
5. Another creation of Allah who cannot be seen are the **angels**. The angels are created from **light**.

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- Al-Muawwizatain which means ‘the two (chapters) of Refuge’ refer to the last 2 Surahs of the Quran: Surat Al-Falaq and Surat An-Nas.
- These 2 Surahs begin with the verse “*Say, I seek refuge in....*”
- These 2 surahs were revealed together. They are so close to each other in meaning and the content that they are often recited together.
- The Prophet (PBUH) said that the like of Al Falaq and An Nas has not been seen before and they are incomparable.
