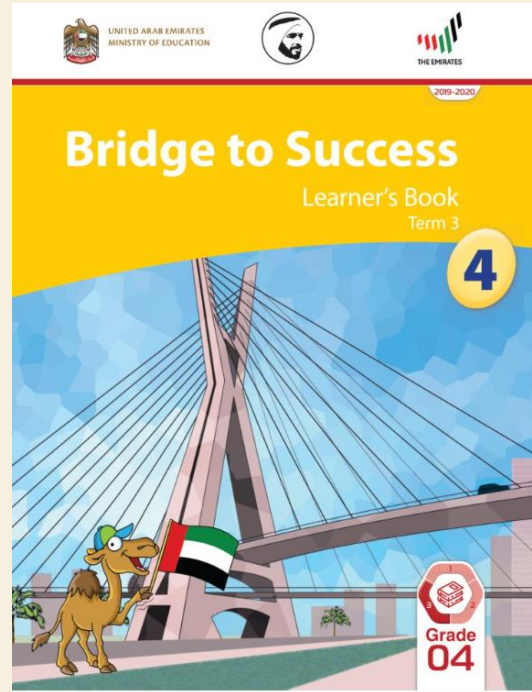
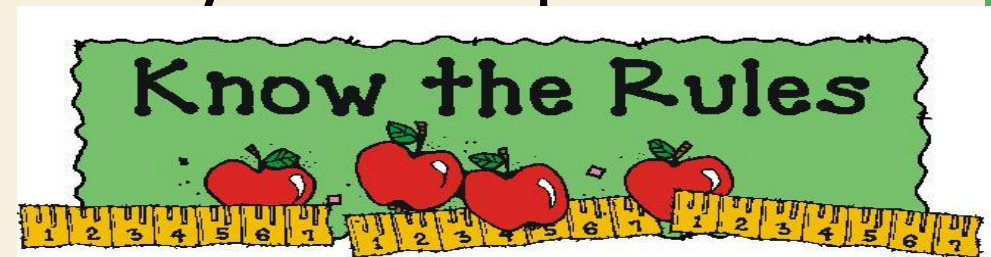


BRIDGE TO SUCCESS

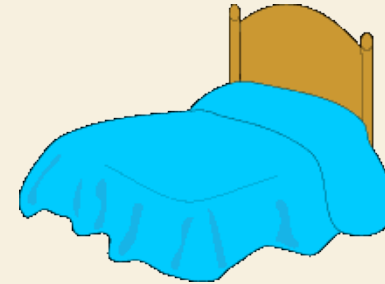

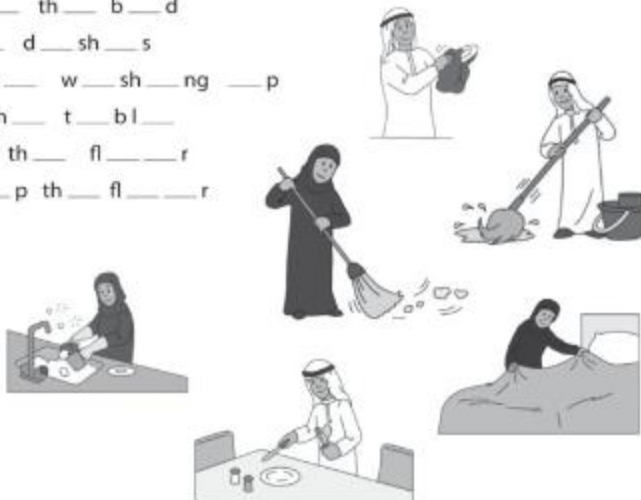
