Reflexive Pronouns:-

reflexive (adj.) [grammar]: reflecting back on the subject, like a mirror

We use a reflexive pronoun when we want to refer back to the subject of the sentence or clause. Reflexive pronouns end in "-self" (singular) or "-selves" (plural).

There are eight reflexive pronouns:

		reflexive pronoun
sing <mark>ular</mark>	I You He/she/it	myself yourself himself, herself, itself
plural	We You They	ourselves yourselves themselves
