Novel [Prisoner of Zenda]

(1) Answer the following questions:

1. To show his people that their king trusts them.
2. It means that Duke Michael's men already had the real king as a prisoner in Zenda.
3. He wouldn't kill the real king until Rudolf is out of the way, they would gain nothing by killing the king and put Rudolf on the throne.
4. They were dangerous and well trained soldiers. Three of them were Ruritaniens and the other three were foreigners. They were famous that they could cut a throat [kill any one] if Michael ordered them
5. To let them know him well and kill him if they saw him again.
6. They couldn't fight Micheal and get the king because how can the king for no clear reason suddenly attack his dear brother Micheal and the people would not accept it.
7. He told him that if Michael took over the throne, he would kill the king and them too!
8. To stop him from attending the coronation and to take over the throne. He sent him a drugged bottle of wine which he couldn't resist,
9. Rassendyll kept Micheal's waiting and didn't give him permission to come in, as he didn't know the rule that no one could come in without permission while the king was in Flavia's house.
10. Rudolf used an iron tea table. He held it by its legs, its top gave him a complete protection to his body against Michael's famous three who came to kill him but he went into Michael's men using this table as he promised not to start shooting unless they do.



11. Sapt interrupted the conversation between Flavia and Rudolf as he, as a man of honour, was about to tell her the truth that he was not the real king as she had told him that she loved him lately since the day of the coronation which means she loved the character of Rudolf Rassendyll and not Rudolf the fifth.
12. When the imprisoned king asked Rupert about the pipe which they were putting up across the window of the castle of Zenda to the moat, Rupert answered that that pipe was the imprisoned king's path or way to heaven which meant that after he would be killed his body would be weighted and put in that pipe sliding it down to sink and settle at the bottom of the moat.
13. If there was an attack on the imprisoned king's room, two of the guards would defend it while the other[Rupert or Detchard] would run in and kill the king who was unarmed and had his hands tied with light steel chains to prevent much movement.
14. He came to Zenda at the request of the British ambassador as a young country man of some rank was missing in England. His friends had not heard from him for two months. After the inquiries, It was known from his friends, railway officials that he was last seen in Zenda . They thought he was in love with Madame de Mauban and followed her to Zenda ; his name was Rassendyll.
15. Detchard ran to the imprisoned king's room [once he saw Rassendyll was fighting with Bersonin] to kill the real king. He killed the loyal doctor who was trying to defend the sick king then while he was fighting with Rassendyll, he stepped in the blood flowing from the dead doctor. Then, he slipped and fell and Rassendyll killed him.



16. Because Sir Jacob was to be an ambassador and he [Rassendyll] was going to Strelsau [in Ruritania]. Rassendyll didn't want to join him there in order to keep what happened there as a secret and not to be known among the people in Ruritania if they noticed how he looked like the real king. Another reason was that the idea of being an ambassador there could hardly attract him as he had been a king there.

(2) Comment

- 1- Sapt said that to Rudolf Rassendyll in the hunting lodge after they killed some of Michael's men. It was a kind of revenge because Josef gave the king the bottle of wine which he took from Black Michael, so the king was drugged. It shows that they succeeded to take their revenge.
- 2- Colonel Sapt said that to Rudolf Rassendyll in the hunting lodge after the king was drugged when he drank the wine from the bottle which was sent by Black Michael. Black Michael sent this bottle in order not to let Rudolf the fifth, the king attend his coronation. Therefore, Sapt persuaded Rudolf Rassendyll to play the role of the king. This shows that Sapt is intelligent & loyal to the king.
- 3- Rudolf Rassendyll said that to Black Michael in Flavia's palace after the coronation. Rudolf Rassendyll and sapt went to get the king back from the hunting lodge. They fought with Michael's men, so he had a wounded finger. He meant that Michael was the dog and Black Michael understood that. It was a kind of warning to Black Michael if that dog tried to bite him again, he would kill him.



- 4- Colonel Sapt said that to Rudolf Rassendyll in the hunting lodge after the king was drugged when he drank the wine from the bottle which was sent by Black Michael. Sapt persuaded Rudolf to play the role of the king, but Rudolf thought that the king would never forgive them because he took his position. It shows that Sapt was loyal and responsible for his country.
- 5- Rudolf Rassendyll said that to Rose in his brother's house when she was trying to encourage Rudolf to have a job and to work because he was twenty nine years old and he had done nothing. It shows that he was lazy and irresponsible.
- 6- Antoinette de Mauban said these words to Rudolf Rassendyll in the summer house when she was justifying to him why she was helping him in order to save his life, the real king's life and his throne from Duke Michael. She was jealous of princess Flavia, she didn't want Michael to be the king in order not to marry her.
- 7- Marshal Strakencz the head of the Ruritanian army said these words to Rudolf Rassendyll when Rudolf was about to travel to Zenda on a hunting trip [of course in reality to rescue the real king] and told the Marshal what to do if the king was killed as he meant himself by saying "the king".
- 8- These words were said by Rudolf Rassendyll to the young pretty girl [the hotel owner's daughter] as he asked her to meet Johann [the guard of Michael's forest] to set a trap for him to get information from him about the castle in Zenda.



- 9- These words were said by Rupert [one of the famous six] to Rudolf Rassendyll while he was delivering him a message from Black Michael .It was an offer of having 100 thousand pounds and a safe journey to the border. They wanted him to stop acting as a king leaving the throne to Black Michael.
- 10- These words were said by the real king [Rudolf the fifth who was drugged and imprisoned in the castle of Zenda by his brother Black Michael ; the Duke of Strelsau] to one of Michael's men [Rupert] as he was very sick in his prison, in fact , he was too weak to move, his life was really in danger.
- 11- These words were said by Rupert [one of Michael's Famous Six] to Rudolf Rassendyll while he was making him a better offer than the one he received from Michael. The new offer meant to Rassend to be disloyal to the real king to win the throne and princess Flavia and to Rupert to be disloyal to Black Michael to have a high position and the thanks of Rassendyll.
- 12- These words were said by Rupert [one of Michael's famous six] to Rudolf Rassendyll while there was a procession coming from the castle of Zenda with a funeral carriage. So, Rassendyll asked if someone is dead. Then, he knew from Rupert that one of the famous six was dead [of course he was killed by Rassendyll's men] . That's why Rupert said these words, of course he meant by “others” Rassendyll himself and his men.



- 13- These words were said by Rudolf Rassendyll to himself when he was about to strike "Max Holf"[Johann's brother] with his knife as he was guarding the pipe { the path to heaven } in the castle of Zenda. Then, he brought his knife down in his heart.
- 14- These words were said by Sapt to princess Flavia when the farmer's daughter told her that the king is wounded and that he was lying in the bushes [in the forest] while Marshal Strakencz was telling her that he was wounded but he was at the castle of Zenda . Then, she accompanied the farmer's daughter to find out the truth. Sapt meant Rudolf Rassendyll [he was not the real king] who was wounded and now lying in front of the princess in the forest.
- 15- These words were said angrily by Black Michael to Rupert when he entered Antoinette de Mauban's room in the castle of Zenda and the Duke was surprised to find him there ; he was disloyal to his lord. Michael meant by these words that Rupert can be killed and thrown in the moat like the king ; he was threatening him.
- 16- These words were said by Rudolf Rassendyll to Rudolf the fifth [the real king] in the castle of Zenda as the real king was recovering and Rassendyll was paying him a visit. The real king wished he could keep Rassendyll with him in Ruritania but Sapt and the Marshal said that it was impossible.



Literature (Arabic Section)

Novel: “Prisoner of Zenda”

1- What was the Rudolf’s plan to save the king’s life?

As he was leaving Strelsan for Zend, he told Marshal Strakencz that he will send a message for three days, but if no messages arrive for three days; he must remove Black Michael from his positions as a governor of Strelsan and put himself in that position. Then he must ask Michael to see the king; if he doesn’t bring the king, it means that the king is dead and the Marshal should announce the new ruler Princess Flavia and kill Duke Michael.

2- Why did Rudolf Rassendyll choose the ten gentlemen carefully?

Because they were all loyal to the king. They knew only some of the truth that he had been attacked in the summerhouse. They also knew that a friend of the king was a prisoner in the castle of Zenda and that they were there to rescue him.

3- Who were the six gentlemen whom Fritz & Sapt talked about to Rassendyll?

They are six gentlemen who belong to Black Michael body and soul; three Ruritaniens, a Frenchman, a Belgian and Englishman. They are all loyal to Michael and would kill anyone if Michael commanded it.

4- What did Fritz and Sapt ask Rudolf to do? Did Rudolf agree to do it?!

Fritz and Sapt asked Rudolf to pretend that he is the king instead of the real king –Rudolf the fifth- as he was drugged and fainted. Because the king had to attend his coronation on the next day. Rudolf Rassendyll agreed to do what Fritz & Sapt ask him to do but he was hesitated at first but accepted to save the king’s life and his throne.



5- Why did Rudolf decide to visit Ruritania?!

Rudolf had much free time and he was about to be the Ambassador's assistant in six months' time. So he decided to visit Ruritania, the important country which he had never visited. At the same time, he could attend the coronation of the new king.

(2) Comment:

- 1- "We know Duke Michael, he has lived among us. Everyone in Ruritania knows him. But few people really know the new king because he travels abroad so much."

The old lady (the inn's owner) said that to Rudolf Rassendyll when he was received at the inn. This shows that the king is careless and he didn't care about his people.

- 2- "We must send word that he is ill, but if he's not crowned today, he'll never be crowned."

Colonel Sapt said that to Rudolf Rassendyll when the king was fainted after drinking drugged wine at the castle of Zenda. He was given this wine by his brother the Black Michael. And this reflects that Michael was a greedy man who is trying to get the authority on Ruritania.

- 3- "I am jealous, I shall not let him marry her! Now go. And remember that you are never safe."

Antoinette De Mauban had said that to Rudolf Rassendyll in the summer house before he decided to get back to Strelsau. And this means that Madame De Mauban loved Duke Michael very much and on the other hand she was trying to save the king's life.



- 4- "Tell them to ride on, I shall ride on alone. I want my people to see that their king trusts them".

Rudolf Rassendyll said that to Marshal Strakencz during the celebration of the king's coronation when he was walking in the narrow streets of Strelesau where the poor live. He was a very brave man and wanted the people of Ruritania love their king.

- 5- "Promise that you will kill the animal black Michael and protect the princess until your death."

Rudolf Rassendyll had said that to the Marshal Strakencz in Strelesau because he was leaving for Zenda to save the king's life. This shows that Rassendyll is so loyal to his country.

Chapters (6 up to 10)

- 1) Rudolf felt sorry for killing Max Holf because he doesn't like to kill a man in behind but he kept convincing himself that it was a war and the king's life is in danger and he has to save his life so he killed Max.
- 2) Rupert proved to be dishonest man when he told Rudolf about his offer which was to kill Sapt, Fritz and Rudolf the fifth, then to kill Duke Michael his own master . In this way Rudolf will be the king and he will marry princess Flavia and Rupert will have Madam Antoinette.
- 3) Rudolf sent a letter to Madam Antoinette to tell to scream at two o'clock asking Michael to help her and she has to mention Rupert's name. and this was part of his plan. The letter was written in French because Johann will not be able to read it.



- 4) Rudolf second plan to save the king that he will swim in the moat and he asked Johann to open the drawbridge at two o'clock to help Sapt and Fritz to attack the castle and he asked Madam Antoinette to scream asking for Michael's help and he will try to kill Hentzau and the Six men.
- 5) Rudolf told Marshal Strakencz to hide their leaving from Flavia and if they didn't return he has to go to the castle of Zenda and to ask to see the king and if Michael wasn't there he has to take Flavia to Strelsau and announce the possible death of the king and that Flavia is the Queen of Ruritania.
- 6) Rupert was ready to betray his own master because he wanted to take his position and to marry Madam Antoinette. Also , he was greedy person and dishonest man he wanted to take everything from Duke Michael.
- 7) It was impossible to wait any longer to save the king because Rudolf knew from Johann that the king is very weak and ill and he could die any time so they had to move quickly to save the king's life.
- 8) Johann didn't open the door because he rushed to help Michael's life when he heard his screaming .Sapt and Fritz broke the door and attacked the castle.
- 9) when Madam Antoinette screamed asking for Michael's help Rupert rushed to her after Michael because he also heard his name and there they had a fight and Rupert killed Michael his own master.



- 10) Rudolf the Fifth tried to save Rudolf Rassendyll's life while he was fighting Detchard and Detchard was about to kill Rudolf Rassendyll so the king took a chair and throw it at Detchard.
- 11) Rupert took a horse from a young farm girl and used it to run away because he heard Fritz's voice and he was shooting guns and he knew that he won't be able to fight them alone so he decided to run away.
- 12) when she was in her way to visit Rudolf in the castle of Zenda she met the young farm girl and she told her that the king is not in the castle and that he is in the forest with Sapt and Fritz so Flavia asked her to take her to them and when she arrived she put her hands on his face and told him you are my king you are the man I love in this moment Sapt and Fritz told her that he is not the king but he is the man you love.
- 13) Flavia proved that she is a responsible person because she refused to go with Rudolf the man she love and she sacrificed her love because she has her own duties toward her country as she is going to be the queen of Ruritania.
- 14) The king wanted Rudolf to stay with him to tell everyone about what he had done but Sapt refused because they have to keep everything secret. No one knows about anything except Sapt, Fritz, Flavia, and Johann and Madam Antoinette promised not to tell anyone about anything.



Comments:

1) "Ask my brother to kill me, I'm slowly dying here"

These words were said by Rudolf the fifth in the prison of Zenda when he was talking with Detchard asking him to tell his brother to kill him because he was very ill and he was dying slowly in the prison.

2) "The duke doesn't desire your death yet"

These words were said by Detchard (one of the loyal six) to Rudolf the fifth in the prison of Zenda when the king asked him to ask his brother to kill him but Detchard told him that his brother doesn't want to kill him now and when he desires that he will kill him.

3) "I have pretended to be the king to help the king , but I'll not do it to help myself"

These words were said by Rudolf Rassendyll to Sapt in the Tarlenheim castle when was telling Sapt his plan to save the king and this shows how much Rudolf was so loyal and honest man and that he didn't care about his life, the only thing that he cares about is to save the king's life.

4) "One man might go unseen, but two will double the risk"

These words were said by Rudolf Rassendyll to Sapt in the Tarlenheim castle when Sapt told him that he wants to swim with him in the moat to help him to save the king but Rudolf refused because they could see them in the moat and this shows that Rudolf is aware about every small detail in his plan to be able to save the king and the he is a brave man.



5) "please, don't let her forget to scream at two o'clock"

These words were said by Rudolf Rassendyll to himself when he was swimming in the moat outside the castle of Zenda to save the king's life when he saw Madam Antoinette through her window and he was worried that she may forget her role in the plan which is to scream at two o'clock.

6) "You have threatened Rudolf Rassendyll a great deal, and yet he is still alive"

These words were said by Rupert Hentzau to Duke Michael when Michael threatened him when he found him in Madam Antoinette's room. And Rupert told him that he had threatened Rudolf before and he is still alive so he will not be able to kill him too. This shows that Rupert is ready to betray his own master and that he is a dishonest man.

7) "Help Michael Help, Hentzau"

These words were said by Madam Antoinette in the castle of Zenda when she was screaming (as Rudolf told her to do) to let Michael come to her room thinking that Rupert is attacking her. And this was part of Rudolf's plan to save the king's life. This shows that Madam Antoinette wanted to save the king because she didn't want Michael to kill him to marry Flavia.

8) "It's Cousin Rudolf, Cousin Rudolf, I'll help you Cousin Rudolf"

These words were said by Rudolf the fifth to Rudolf Rassendyll in the prison of Zenda when Rudolf was fighting with Detchard and Detchard was about to kill him. This shows that the king was very ill and weak but he tried to save Rudolf's life.
