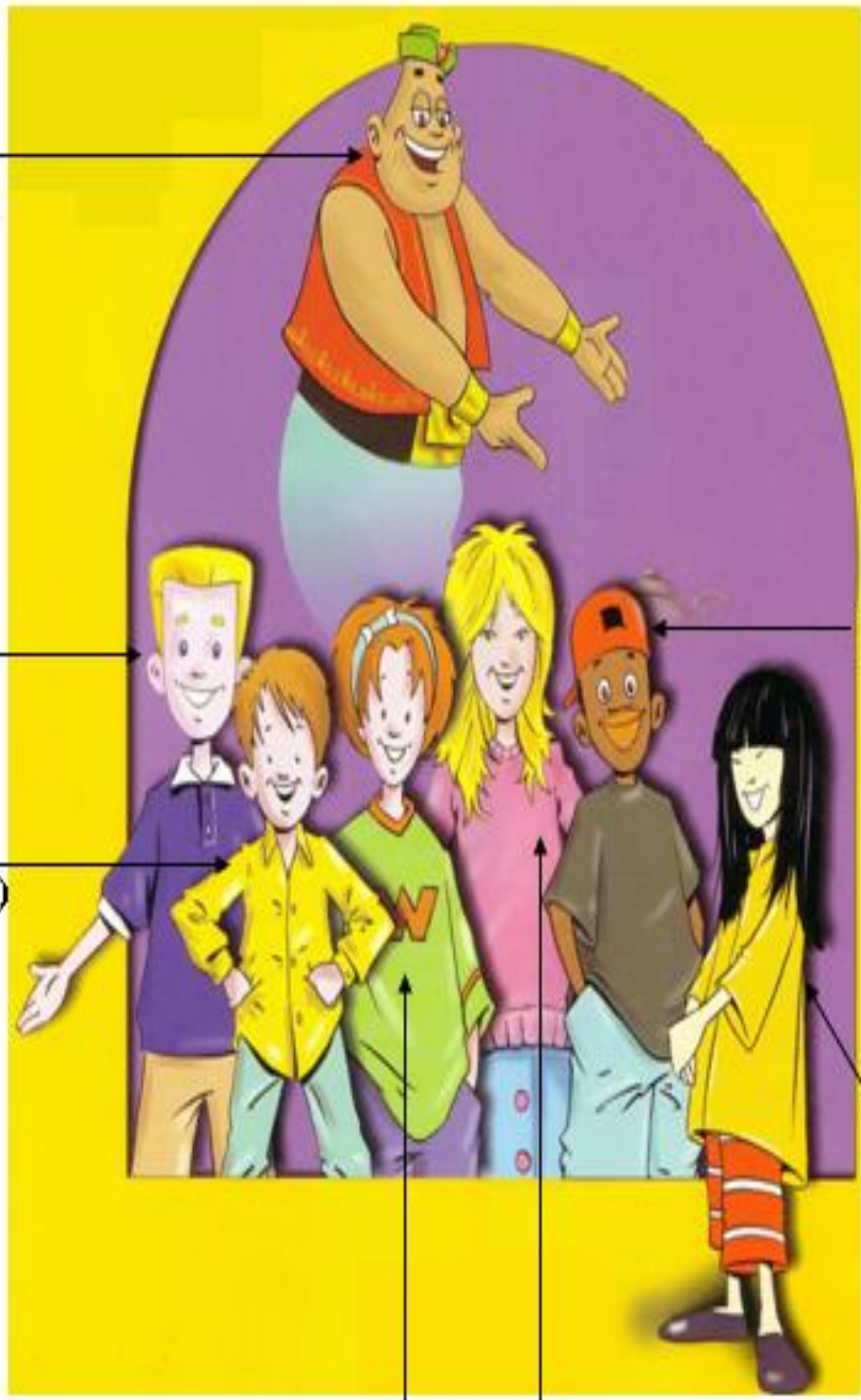

-This tense expresses an action that started and ended in the past

❖ **Formation**

-We add –d or –ed to the regular verbs

-watchwatched - arrive.....arrived

❖ **Notice:**

❶ When the verb ended with a consonant preceded by a vowel, we double the last letter and then add –ed

stop stopped beg begged

❷ When the verb ends with a consonant preceded by two vowels, we do not double the last letter, we just add –ed to the verb

rain rained gain gained greet greeted

③ When the verb ends with -y, we turn the -y to -i and then add -ed

study studied **marry** married **carry** carried

④ When the verb ends with -y, preceded by a vowel, we just add -ed without any changes

❖ On & In

-On is used before dates and days of the week

On Monday – on 1st October 2002

-In is used before the months, the seasons, years and parts of the day

In May – in winter – in the morning – in the evening – in 2003

-To ask about a date or the place of birth

When were you born ? → I was born in 1997

When was [he – she] born ? → He [She] was born in 2001.

Where were you born ? → I was born in Cairo.

-We use the verb (play) with musical instruments

Play the [piano – guitar – violin]

STRUCTURE

Ability in the past

-Could is used to express ability in the past

❖ **Could = [was – were able to + base verb]**

- I could ride a bike when I was young.

= I was able to ride a bike when I was young.

- She could swim when she was six.

-For negative we use

❖ **Couldn't + base verb**

- He couldn't walk until he was three
- I couldn't play the guitar when I was seven .



Comparative and Superlative Adjectives

1- Comparative adjectives (one-syllable adjectives/ short adjectives)

-To compare between two persons or two things

-We add -er to the adjective, and then we put than after the adjective

- ❖ - Ali is taller than Hani.
- ❖ - Cairo is bigger than Luxor.

-Some Notes

-When the adjective ends with -y, preceded by a consonant, we change the -y to -i and then we add the -er

- happy → happier - lucky → luckier - funny → funnier

-When the adjective ends with a consonant, preceded by a vowel, we double the last letter and then we add the -er

- fat → fatter - big → bigger - thin → thinner

-When the adjective ends with -ow, we just add -er

- narrow → narrower

2. Comparative adjectives (more than one-syllable adjectives/ long adjectives)

❖ More + adjective + than

Heba is more beautiful than Mona .

The lion is more dangerous than the dog .

❖ Less + adjective + than

Mona is less beautiful than Heba .

The dog is less dangerous than the lion .

-When two things or two people are the same/ equal we use:

❖ [As + adj + as] & [So + adj + as]

- Noura is as pretty as Hala .

- Noura is so pretty as Hala .

❖ [not as + adj + as] & [not so + adj + as]

- She is not as tall as her sister . = Her sister is taller than her .

- Ali is not as fat as Hani . = Hani is fatter than Ali .

2- Superlative adjectives

-To compare a person or a thing to a group

-We add -est to the adjective and the before the adjective

- Suzy is ***the tallest*** girl in class .
- He is ***the fattest*** of his friends
- She is ***the oldest*** of all the girls .

-Some Notes

-We use in after the adjective when it is followed by a place

-We can use of/ of all when the adjective is followed by people

❖ Superlative adjectives (more than one-syllable adjectives/ long adjectives)

❖ The most + adj

- The lion is the most dangerous animal .

❖ The least + adj

- Fiat is the least expensive car .

❖ Irregular Adjectives

Good	Better than	The best
Bad	Worse than	The worst
Much – many	More than	The most
Little	Less than	The least
Far	Farther – further than	The farthest - furthest

- Ali is a good man .
- Hani is better than Ali.
- Omar is the best.

❖ **Farthest is followed by from, and nearest by to:**

- Aswan is *the farthest* town *from* Cairo .
- Benha is **the nearest** town **to** Cairo .

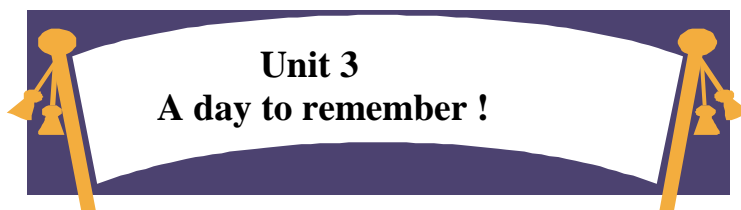

Adverbs

❖ We use adverbs to describe a verb, an adjective or another adverb

- She walks **slowly**. (verb)
- She is **very** good at English. (adjective)
- She walks **very** slowly. (adverb)

❖ The adverb could be one word (slowly), or a phrase (in the house)

❖ Adverbs of manner

❖ Most adverbs are formed by adding **-ly** to the adjectives

- slow → slowly quiet → quietly quick → quickly
- usual → usually careful → carefully

❖ Adjectives end with **-le**, we delete the **-e** and then add **-y**

- horrible → horribly possible → possibly

❖ Adjectives end with **-y**, we change the **-y** to **-i** and then add **-ly**

- easy → easily funny → funnily happy → happily

❖ **These verbs (feel-be-become) are used with the adjectives to express feelings**

- He is happy . = He feels happy .
- She was worried . = She felt worried .
- We became bored . = We felt bored.

❖ **How.....? is used to ask about feelings**

- **How do you feel ?** → I feel tired .
- **How did you feel when you saw the snake ?**
→ I felt frightened .

❖ **Why.....? is used to ask about the reason**

- **Why are you so bored ?**

→ Because I haven't got anything to do .

- **Why are you afraid ?**

→ Because I don't like spiders .

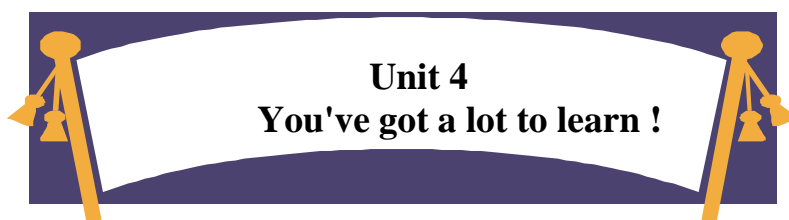

❖ Form

[Have – Has + verb pp]

- He has played football.
- She has cooked dinner.

❖ Usage

-It is used with something happened in the past and still continues to happen till now

- We have lived in Cairo since 1998.

-It is used to express something happened in the past, but its effect is still in the present

- My father has bought a new car.

❖ Key words

-just

- He has just had dinner.

-Already

- I have already watered the flowers.

-Yet (with negative and interrogative)

- Has he phoned yet ?
- He hasn't phoned yet.

-So far –up to now

- We haven't had any problems so far.
- He hasn't won any prize up to now.

-Since

1998 – last May – my birthday party – I was a child – 3 o'clock

- How long have you lived in Cairo ?

I have lived in Cairo since [1998 – I was a child].

-For

3 years – a month – 2 weeks – an hour – along time

- I have lived in Cairo for 3 years .

-Note: For could be used with the present perfect or the past simple

- I have lived in Cairo for 2 years . [still]
- I lived in Cairo for 2 years . [I don't live there anymore]

-Note: How long.....? Is used to ask about the duration with statements with since and for

❖ Has been to.....?/ Have been to.....? To ask about past experiences

-He has been to London.

❖ Note the difference:

- She has gone to Paris . [she is there now]
- She has been to Paris . [but she isn't there now]

-Ever (is used to answer questions about experiences)

- Have you ever been to the U.S.A ? → I have been to the U.S.A .

-Never

- I have never been to the USA

❖ Forming Questions
