Vocabulary مفردات الوحدة

Acquaintances (n) معارف → When you know people slightly, but they aren't close friends.

Adopted (adj) متبنى → a person who has been permanently taken into the custody of an adult who acts as that person's parent.

Be open with يكون مفتحا على أمر ما → speak or act freely and frankly to someone or something.

Best friend (n) الصديق المفضل → A friend you like most compared to others.

Bride (n) عروس → A woman on her wedding day or just before and after the event.

Close friend (n) الصديق المقرب → A friend who is loyal to you and saves secrets.

Companion (n) رفقة أو رفيق → A person or animal with whom one spends a lot of time or with whom one travels.

Contact (n) اتصال → The action of communicating or meeting.

Exchange rings تلبس الخواتم → Wearing rings in the wedding day in which a husband and his wife exchange rings with each other.

Bossy (adj) متسلط / مترأس → Fond of giving people orders.

Generous (adj) كريم → Showing a readiness to give more of something, especially money, than is strictly necessary or expected.

Gentle (adj) لطيف / أنيق → Moderate in action, effect, or degree; not strong or violent.

Helpful (adj) **متعاون / يحب المساعدة** → Ready to give help or useful.

Kind (adj) **لطيف** → People who are generous, helpful, and who think of other people's feelings.

Nervous (adj) **عصبي / متوتر** → Easily agitated or alarmed.

Rude (adj) **وقح** → An impolite person.

Selfish (adj) **أناني / محب لذاته** → Concerned with him or herself and neglects others' needs.

Shy (adj) **خجول** → Nervous or timid in the company of other people.

Get married (v) **يتزوج** → To begin a legal relationship with someone as their husband or wife.

Get on well with **ينشئ علاقة / يعتاد على شيء** → to have a good relationship or deal successfully with a situation.

Gifts (n) **هدايا** → A thing given willingly to someone without payment; a present.

Strict (adj) **حازم / صارم / ملتزم** → A person who follows rules or beliefs exactly.

Sweet (adj) **حلو / جميل** → Pleasing in general; delightful.

Vain (adj) **مغرور** → Too proud of your own appearance, abilities, achievements, etc.

Gives a speech **يقدم خطاب للناس** → A formal talk given usually to a large number of people on a special occasion.

Good friends **أصدقاء جيدين** → Honest and speak from the heart with good intentions.

Groom (n) **عريس** → The husband.

Guests (n) **ضيوف** → A person who is invited to visit someone's home.

Invitation (n) **دعوة لمناسبة** → The action of inviting someone to go somewhere or to do something.

Invite (v) **يدعو لمناسبة** → Make a polite, formal request to someone to go somewhere.

Keep in touch **ابقى على اتصال** → To continue to talk to or write to someone.

Let somebody down **يخذل شخص ما** → To disappoint someone.

Make friends with **ينشئ صداقة / يصادق** → To begin a friendship with others.

Newlyweds (n) **متزوجون حديثا** → People who have recently entered into a marriage.

Rely on **معتمد على** → Depend on someone or something.

Bilingual (adj) ثنائي اللغة → Speaking two languages fluently.

Find the right word يجد الكلمة الصحيحة → To find a word that is right and suitable.

Improve (v) يحسن / يطور → Make or become better.

Make a mistake يقرئ خطأ → Doing something incorrectly.

Mix up languages خلط اللغات → When someone mix more than one language while speaking indeliberately.

Pronunciation (n) لفظ الكلام → The way in which a word is pronounced.

Share your feelings تشارك الأحاسيس → To talk about your opinions, likes, fears, etc.

Trilingual (adj) ثلاثي اللغة → Speaking three languages fluently.

Spend more time with تقضي وقت أطول مع → Sacrificing your time with someone or something.

Understand English (v) يفهم اللغة الإنجليزية → To know how to speak, write, listen and read the English language.

Turn my back on يتجاهل / يدير ظهره لشخص ما → To ignore, leave, or reject someone or something.

Twin (n-adj) توأم → One of two children or animals born at the same birth.

Wedding dress (n) فستان الزفاف → A dress that a bride puts on in the wedding day.

Wedding reception (n) حفلة ما بعد العرس للتهنئة → a party usually held after the completion of a marriage ceremony.
