## BUT

- We add -es to verbs that end in -ss,
   -sh, -ch, -x, -o.
   I watch he watches
  - With verbs ending in consonant + y,

we change the -y to -ies.

I cry - he cries

But with verbs ending in vowel + y,
we just add -s as usual.

I play - he plays
