For a continuing unfinished action interrupted by sudden past action.

While we were listening to the teacher, someone knocked on the door.

While he was packing his bag, the telephone rang.

### Used to

\* Used for describing habits in the past.

She used to travel to Alex.

They used to go to school by bus.

He used to ride a bike.

**\* Adjectives end with (y) we change it into (l + ly) to make adverb:**

funny → funnily

angry → angrily

happy → happily

She is happy. She speaks happily.

He is lazy. He works lazily.
