Interviewer: Can you tell us what is in the cake?

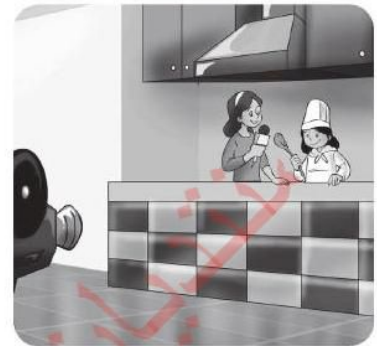
Sandy: Sure. There are some flour, some butter and some eggs in the cake.
