

Comparatives

We use comparatives to compare two things. To compare two things, you have to change the adjective.

- For one syllable adjectives, add 'er' to the end of the adjective.
- For one syllable adjectives that end in 'e', only add 'r' to the end of the adjective.
- For two syllable adjectives that end in 'y', remove the 'y' and add 'ier'.
- · Double the final consonant if there is a vowel before it.






